

IB Diploma Programme

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma
Programme (DP) is a rigorous, two-year, liberal arts
curriculum that develops the individual talents of
young people and relates their classroom experience
to the world around them. Students who complete
the full requirements of the IB Diploma Programme
(required GPA, TOK, CAS, Extended Essay) in Grades
11 and 12 and who pass six IB exams are eligible to
receive the IB Diploma in addition to their high school
diploma.

IB Career-related Programme
