- Roll called and quorum established
- Membership reviewed April 10, 2018 minutes
 - Mrs. Coles made motion to approve
 - Mrs. Valerie Lewin seconded
- Principal's Address
 - Thanked PTSA and YMCA for dinner
 - Seniors
 - 8 days and 4 days exams left
 - Exam exemptions discussed
 - Remaining events: graduation (6/3), prom 5/18 @ Shooters, and BBQ
 - Graduation is a celebration! Seniors may decorate their caps with pictures related to chosen college and career.
 - Once seniors are gone- one magical week with underclassmen and finals. Students' last day is June 6 and Teacher Planning's on June 7.
 - Identification (IDs)
 - Not every kid wears an ID
 - We're able to identify strangers on campus
 - Next year- ID from day one
 - User friendly with class color lanyard
