# BROWARD COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD DRESS CODE

Parents, please remember to have your children follow Broward County School Board's policy on dress code. "Backless footwear is not allowed" and, for the safety of the children, closed-toed athletic shoes should be

worn as they participate in physical education/recess daily. Additionally, "revealing clothing or clothing that exposes the torso is not allowed." This includes "tank tops or spaghetti straps without overblouses or jackets." Finally, clothing that "exposes the upper thigh is not allowed" in grades 4 and 5. "For Pre-K-3rd grade, shorter shorts may be worn since these are standard attire for these ages."

# **Arrival Reminders:**

Supervision of students begins at 7:55 AM. Please do not arrive before 7:55 AM unless your child is enrolled in the Before School Care Program. Drop off for Before Care is in the front office car loop between 6:55 AM and 7:55 AM. You MUST walk your child in EVERY DAY to sign your student in to Before Care. NO OTHER CARES SHOULD UTILIZE THE FRONT CAR LOOP UNTIL 7:55 AM because it blocks the Before Care drop off. Please utilize our established car loops from 7:55 AM - 8:25 AM. Please DO NOT utilize the north parking lot for student drop off as this is a major safety hazard.

# Dismissal Reminders:

Please do not arrive too early before 2:25 PM. We have 27 busses and many private aftercare vans that must enter and load just before 2:25 PM. For the front loop, do not block the entrance and exits to the car loop, parking lot, and bus loop. Please not fill the north end of 66th Avenue with cars as this prevents busses from having the turning room to depart. Finally, please do not drive on the wrong side of the road.
