

Writing Practice

How do you feel you did on the writing test? Do you think you did good? Did you do all the things to write a good essay like... complete paragraphs, a hook, state evidence from the passage then elaborate, and/or restate?

Math Practice

Writing – Short Response

1. Underline important details in the prompt. This will help you better understand what the prompt is telling you.

Math

- 1. If you don't know an answer to a question, don't sit there and try to figure it out, move to the next question and come back to the ones you're stuck on later.
- 2. Once you finish, if you still have time left over always use that to double-check your answers.

Reading

- 1. Keep track of your time. PACE YOURSELF!
- 2. Look for key words and use context clues. Skimming and scanning will definitely help you find the answer, but don't do it unless you know what key words you're looking for.
- 3. Always look back in the text if you're not sure of an answer. Doing this will help you better understand the question and lead you to getting the answer correct.
