Testing Schedule

- ✓ If a student has technical difficulties on the day of the exam, he/she will need to contact College Board directly. There should be a link in the student's exam of where to contact.
- ✓ We want to encourage students to take their exam on the normal scheduled test date. If for some reason, a student misses the window for general testing, the student will receive a notification from College Board to test in the make- up window. After the make-up window, there is no other test date.



At-Home Exam Experience

- ✓ In late April, College Board will provide AP students and educators with information on how to access the testing system on test day, and video demonstrations so that students can familiarize themselves with the system. There will be a testing guide that comes out next week.
 - Students can participate in an at-home exam experience to get them acquainted with online testing format.
 - There will be a webinar for the at-home exam experience from April 28th April 30th



Test Format

- ✓ Students will either type their answers into College Board or handwrite/take screenshot/upload.
 - The choice is theirs.
- ✓ Helpful typing websites
 - Nitro Type
 - Free Typing Lesson
 - Timed Typing Practice
- ✓ AP Classroom has FRQ examples and Testing Guide will provide information on uploading and practicing.



Exam Security

- ✓ Tests will be open note/open book.
- ✓ Students cannot consult with anyone during the testing time (including their teacher).
- ✓ Plagiarism detection software will be used.
- ✓ Consequences for violating exam security....
 - ☐ Cancelled scores
 - ☐ Blocked from College Board and taking other exams in the future (SAT, AP exams)
 - ☐ Informing current high school and applied colleges of the infraction.
 - Potential law enforcement interference



Things to do Before Exam Day for Students

- All students MUST be able to log into their College Board account linked with their AP
 Classroom and that their College Board account is up to date.
 - If they forgot their password, please have them click "Forgot Password". If that still does not work, they will need to call the Student Helpline to reset it. 888-225-5427
- 2. College Board is concerned that school domains block emails and there is a fear that it could block pertinent testing emails from the students.
 - Students NEED to check to make sure that they have been receiving emails from College Board.
 - ➤ It is possible they have changed/updated their email address since earlier in the year.
- 3. <u>Seniors ONLY</u> Sending scores in your University/College
 - Deadline to send your free score report is June 20, 2020
 - Log into your College Board account.
