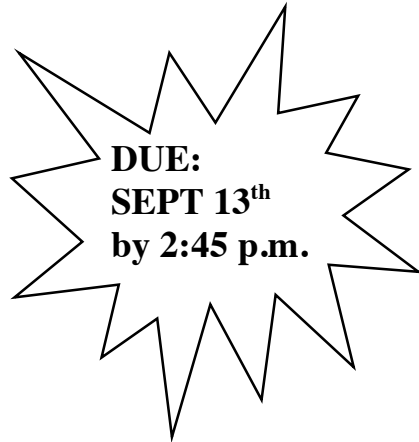
- The **PSAT/NMSQT** will be given at MSD on:
Wednesday, October 16th at 7:40 a.m.
- This test is the “*National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test*” for JUNIORS and can only be taken on this date. There are no makeups.
- A score of 430 on the PSAT/NMSQT “math section” satisfies the Algebra 1 graduation requirement.
- The PSAT/NMSQT is a great practice test for all juniors who have not taken a SAT or ACT. In mid-December, test results (with your original test booklet) will be given to you for review of your strengths and weaknesses.
