# DAILY WELLNESS CHECKS

**Bee-Hive Parents:** To ensure you aren't sending a sick child to school, we strongly encourage you to ask the following questions every morning:

- *Does my child exhibit fever-like symptoms? (i.e. temperature greater than 100.4, chills)*
- *Is my child complaining of a runny nose, sore throat or persistent cough?*
- *Has my child had a recent loss of taste or smell?*
- *Has anyone in my household tested positive for COVID-19?*
- *Has anyone in my household, including my child, been exposed to someone who has COVID-19?*
- *Has my child been told to self-quarantine by a doctor or district official?*



# MASTER SCHEDULE

K-5 Instructional Hours: 8:15 a.m. – 2:45 p.m.

On early release days, the school hours are 8:15 a.m. – 12:45 p.m.

Students who have opted to complete e-Learning at home will conform to the regular hours of instruction.

All teachers will place the revised K-5 instructional schedule on their Canvas homepages.

Due to COVID -19 restrictions, the playground is closed. Students are able to participate in socially distanced activities during the Recess/PE block. Activities include but are not limited to Simon Says, Mother May I, Go Noodle.



# SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Physical Distancing Floor Decals and Posters have been placed throughout the campus and in all classrooms/main gathering areas.

Classrooms have been set up to ensure social distancing.

An isolation room has been added to house any students/staff members exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms.

Two nurses have been assigned to our school.

Sanitation Stations have been set up in all classrooms and main gathering areas (i.e. Inside/Outside Main Office, Old Cafeteria, New Cafeteria, Music Room). All students, staff, visitors are required to sanitize their hands before entering/after leaving the building.

Our security team (Armed Guardian and Campus Monitor) will be present on campus during school hours.



# ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Based on the method of arrival or dismissal, students will report to the following areas:

## BUS RIDERS

- Afternoon Dismissal and Supervision (starting at 2:35 p.m.) – Old Cafeteria
- Rainy Day Dismissal – Old Cafeteria

## CAR RIDERS

- Breakfast and Morning Supervision (7:15 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.) – New Cafeteria
- Afternoon Dismissal and Supervision (starting at 2:40 p.m.) – New Cafeteria
- Rainy Day Dismissal – New Cafeteria

## WALKERS

- Breakfast and Morning Supervision (7:15 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.) – Music Room: 120
- Afternoon Dismissal and Supervision (starting at 2:45 p.m.) – Music Room: 120
- Rainy Day Dismissal – Music Room: 120

**Students who are enrolled in ASP will be picked up at 2:40 by their counselor.**



# UNIFORM/DRESS CODE

## Uniforms

- Students are encouraged to be dressed in uniforms. If you have any questions or need assistance, please call our main office line (754)-322-5550.

## Facial Covering

- Per District Policy, All students are required to wear a facial covering. Please ensure your child is equipped prior to entering the campus.





# ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL GUIDELINES

Parents of Car Riders **MUST** remain in their vehicles.

All students must adhere to the physical distancing guidelines.

Students will be escorted to their assigned dismissal area by a designated staff member.



# STUDENT SUPPLIES

## Laptops

- Students must bring in and take home their school board issued laptop daily.
- Student Laptops must be fully charged prior to the start of the school day.

## Textbooks

- Students must bring in any textbook that is currently being used by their teacher. These items were distributed in August (Grab and Go Academics and Technology).
- If you need assistance in getting these items, please contact our main office line (754-322-5550).

## Supplemental Materials

- Students are encouraged to bring in supplies such as paper, notebooks, pencils, erasers, sharpeners and a water bottle.
- Students will NOT be allowed to share materials.



# CLINIC AND ISOLATION ROOM PROTOCOLS

## CLINIC

- Students with minor injuries will be allowed in the clinic.
- Students who receive medication on site will be escorted to/from their classroom by the nurse or administration.
- The Clinic Nurse will **NOT** assess students who are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.

## ISOLATION ROOM

- If a student exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, the teacher will notify the front office.
- The front office staff will notify administration.
- The Isolation Room Nurse or Administration will immediately escort student from classroom to isolation room
- The Nurse will assess the student and immediately inform the student's parent/guardian.



# PARENT INFORMATION

***To ensure the health and safety of all Broward Estates ES stakeholders, the following guidelines have been implemented:***

Parent/Teacher Conferences will be conducted virtually.

Honor Roll Ceremonies and other celebratory activities will also be conducted virtually.

Prior to entering the main office, all visitors must sanitize their hands and wear a facial covering.

No more than 2 visitors will be allowed in the main office.



# LATE ARRIVALS

## Protocols

- All late arrivals will report to the front office (with adherence to CDC guidelines and protocols).
- Student will be provided with a classroom admittance ticket and escorted to class.

**Attendance Counts: Please make every effort to bring your child to school on time.**



# MORNING PROTOCOLS

## Protocols

- After Breakfast, Students will be escorted to their respective classrooms.
- Classroom Teachers will stand outside their classroom doors ready to receive their scholars at 8:05 a.m.
- Students and Teachers will sanitize their hands and wipe down their assigned areas with disinfectant wipes.



# LUNCHROOM

## Protocols

- 5 minutes before Lunch, Students will sanitize their hands in the classroom.
- Teachers will escort scholars to the cafeteria in a single file socially distanced line.
- Upon arrival, all classes will enter the east side of the cafeteria and sanitize their hands.
- Upon departure, all classes will exit the west side of the cafeteria and sanitize their hands.
- Cafeteria Supervisors will escort classes out of cafeteria; Teachers will receive students by the recess field.



# MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Students in departmentalized classes will remain in their homeroom class. Teachers will transition.

Specials will be conducted virtually.

Grab and Go meals will continue on Tuesdays and Thursdays but will only last one hour (11 a.m. – 12 p.m.)

On Fridays, all scholars will receive a “weekend meal pack.”

Free Lunch Meals will be provided until December 31, 2020. For further information, please contact our main office line.
