- Mr. Toliver reviewed the importance and reasoning of SAC, aligning students, school, and parents working towards a common goal of student achievement.

- Current enrollment: 1,147 students. Which is a little low from the 2021-22 projection of 1,202.
- Budget adjustments due to low enrollment. French Program will gear toward FLVS or alternate programs possibly.
- Parents expressed their concerns with the FLVS option. Parents requested a physical teacher due to the challenges. Toliver reassured the school is working on the needs of both the students' and parents' needs. Toliver expressed he is searching for a French speaking teacher currently employed with Crystal Lake to assist with classes. Parents raised concerns of future enrollment. Toliver expressed the district is experiencing similar issues due to the pandemic and working through all challenges at hand. Parents gave suggestions for contacting Nora Rupert and other district leaders to raise awareness and advocate for the French Department.

 - Various Tic Tok Challenges are going around with students causing damages to school property. The school has spoken with students regarding the challenge.

The program is built around STEM. Currently, 17 positions available. The league has built an alternative location to include with the competitions.
