Floranada Elementary SAC Minutes – for September 19, 2019

Attendance:

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Floranada Elementary School Advisory Council held on September 19, 2019 in the science lab. Co-Chair Ann Landley called the meeting to order at 5:16 p.m. Gina LaBarbera will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Mr. Cherson motioned to approve the minutes of May 2, 2019 as is with no correction and Mrs. Berry seconded.

Old Business:

Smart Bond Project team presented about upcoming projects slated for completion at Floranada Elementary. The Smart Bond Project had funds of \$800 Million to make necessary improvements to schools in need. BCPS identified needed improvements and renovations through a District-wide Needs Assessment. Our building got an evaluation during the Design Phase after the architect/engineer validated it. The building will be receiving HVAC and roof improvements. The Project Manager from the Smart Bond Project reviewed the timeline and process necessary for completion.

SAC discussed changing monthly meetings from the first Thursday of every month to the third Thursday of every month due to conflict in scheduling for members. A member asked for confirmation that our new SAC meetings will occur on the third Thursday of each month. All members are in agreement with the new date.

New Business:

There were opened position for SAC and new nominations came to the floor. The opened positions were SAF Chair, Pre-K, ESOL, and Gifted Representatives. The committee conducted new members' nominations for the opened positions, of which all positions filled. To ensure filling all positions, the members approved a schedule change. Then the committee discussed the SAC meeting days that coincide with early release. The October 17 meeting day will remain the same while the February 20 meeting will change to February 13 and March 19 to March 12. The committee is in favor of the changes.

Reports: Mr. Vetter [principal]

Mr. Vetter reviewed the 2024 Strategic Plan with the members. Also discussed was the new attendance plan in which he discussed how the school plans to reduce the amount of absences. One of the ways discussed was awarding students with perfect attendance [no absences or tardiness] a party for each quarter. Mr. Vetter transitioned his discussion to the A+ ballot, which he distributed an existing copy used prior to the members. A member asked about the status of the digital marquee and the status is unknown. A member asked if there was a need for the allotted 10% of the money to go back to the school. There was a discussion about whether

to give 10% back to the school or not. The SAC committee, after thorough discussion, voted unanimously to approve the ballot. The staff will get the ballot at the next faculty meeting.

Mr. Vetter then reviewed the school test scores with the members followed by the safety audit. FSAAT Safety audit noted four minor changes be made including cameras and new doorknobs but were overall impressed. Each classroom has a paper that tells the location of the room for 911 calls and every staff member has a radio.

Open Agenda

The meeting opened for questions, comments, or concerns from both members and non-members. There were no concerns. Mrs. Balint mentioned the Partner breakfast slated for September 23, 2019 in the media center. Mrs. Brunt shared that Robotics Lincoln Fundraiser will be November 20, 2019 at the school and community members can come and test-drive a car.
