

School Advisory Council (SAC) November 4, 219 Minutes

1. Ms. Oppy welcomed everyone; Ms. Hamid had joined us and put her name on the ballot. We need to have more parents and community members than staff. Ms. Oppy had called and left messages with parents who have shown interest.
2. Ms. Bryan motioned to accept the minutes and Ms. Acevedo seconded the motion
3. We need a second co-chair, or we will need to change the bylaws as well as a new secretary.
4. Mr. Valesco and Ms. Rogers were voted in as members. If you know of any parents invite them to come attend the meeting.
5. Mr. Valesco gave Ms. Oppy the agenda from the north area school advisory council. They noted that they are adding more head start programs, ID badges (students being charged), cell phone motion to collect phones, and school uniforms. We are able to look into requiring school uniforms.
6. Ms. Luckenbach stated that in the past we have voted numerous times in the past on this matter. Historically this has not passed. In order to vote you need to provide samples and plan for families that may have financial difficulty. A few parents have been asking about uniforms and have approached Ms. Lewis. Ms. Bryan spoke about uniforms that her children have had in the past, offering more examples. We would need to consider who will assist with ordering the uniforms. Ms. Oppy will set up a survey to see the parent interest. Mr. Valesco stated that they can enforce it and will speak to Mr. Bold regarding the matter.

Principals Report: last week and the week before we held our just say no to drugs and Ms. Cunningham lead it. The students really enjoyed it and we had a culminating video to highlight the days. We also had our storybook parade on Halloween, and it was a huge success.

Our school store opened for the first time and the students were able to buy prizes with their SOAR tickets.

We received our headphone order for our ESOL students, and will be passed out to teachers. They will be working on the imagine learning program. Ms. Oppy is working with Ms. Dejo and Ms. Milord for ESOL

groups. Our Veterans day lunch is tomorrow. A letter was set home today from Ms. Eagan notifying parents that she has been recommended for a new position in the county. She goes before the school board on Wednesday and our cadre director will be on campus tomorrow to talk about the process for selecting the principal.

Celebrations/ Concerns: Ms. Oppy went to the student government meeting they reviewed recommendations student made and how they categorized them. Ms. Luckenbach stated that they raised 1,200 dollars for the STEM program with the Dominos fundraiser. She is planning on holding a Crispy Cream fundraiser in January. The title one training academy/ workshops will be held on November 21st at Boulevard Heights, December 19th will be held at Atlantic West.
