Violation #13. Food in good condition, safe, & unadulterated

Canned food (diced yellow peaches) with dents on hermetic seal, food adulterated. Remove dented can/provide intact canned food without dents on hermetic seal. Corrected on site

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(1). The food packaging shall not be compromised nor the true appearance, color, or quality of a food be intentionally altered.

Violation #47. Food & non-food contact surfaces

Freezer door insulation in disrepair, ice buildup around reach-in freezer doors. Repair/replace door insulation, maintain equipment in good repair.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Equipment and utensils must be properly designed, constructed, and in good repair.

Violation #56. Ventilation & lighting

Light bulb in hood not working. Replace light bulb.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.
