Dear Parents and/or Guardians,

Students are expected to follow the schoolwide positive behavior plan at Forest Glen Middle School each day. Our teachers and staff spent the first week of school teaching and modeling our **Glen House Rules** for students. Students are expected to be **Responsible, Respectful, & Safe** in the classrooms, hallways, cafeteria, restrooms, and designated before and after school areas (this includes the bus). All grade levels will also participate in student expectations assemblies reiterating our Glen House Rules during the start of each new quarter.

Being Responsible looks like...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attending school regularly • Getting to class on time • Completing & submitting classwork and homework • Using technology & social media in a positive manner • Following school approved dress code
Being Respectful looks like...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Following all reasonable requests from teachers & staff • Being kind to staff and peers • Accepting differences & working through misunderstandings
Being Safe looks like...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Following all reasonable requests from teachers & staff • Keeping body parts and objects to oneself • Reporting any and all unsafe situations • Wearing your ID badge daily (must be on & visible)

Students who follow our **Glen House Rules** of being **responsible, respectful & safe** and exhibit positive behavior choices are rewarded with tickets that they can use to purchase items from our Wildcat Store on scheduled days. In addition to the Wildcat Store, students are also celebrated quarterly with fun events and assemblies for making positive behavior choices. To be eligible to attend these fun quarterly incentive events and assemblies, students must **NOT** have any of the following for each quarter:

1. any suspensions (internal or external)
2. an F in any of their classes
3. 2 or more referrals
4. 4 or more ID badge violations

Eligibility criteria begins fresh again for every student at the start of each new quarter. Every student can make positive choices that will give them a new chance at being celebrated for the new quarter. We will have four incentive events this year that celebrate our students. Students are eligible to attend if they do not have any of the items listed above.

Each student has signed an attendance log that they have received this letter and it is their responsibility to share this information with their parents and/or guardians.
