<b><u>Bottoms</u></b>	Pants or Slacks ( <b><u>must</u></b> be worn on the waist, preferably with a belt)  Shorts or Skirts ( <b><u>must</u></b> reach below the fingertips)	Navy Blue or Khaki  <b><i>*JEANS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.</i></b>
<b><u>Tops</u></b>	Polo style, collared shirt ( <b><u>must</u></b> be visible)  Jacket with a zipper or sweaters <b><u>without</u></b> a hood are acceptable.	White, Navy, Gold or Burgundy  Solid Color (No graphics)
<b><u>Shoes</u></b>	Sneakers/closed toe shoes  Open toed shoes <b><u>not allowed.</u></b>	

**Prohibited Items:** Hats, hoods, flip flops, sandals, slippers, Crocs, and leggings/Spandex.
