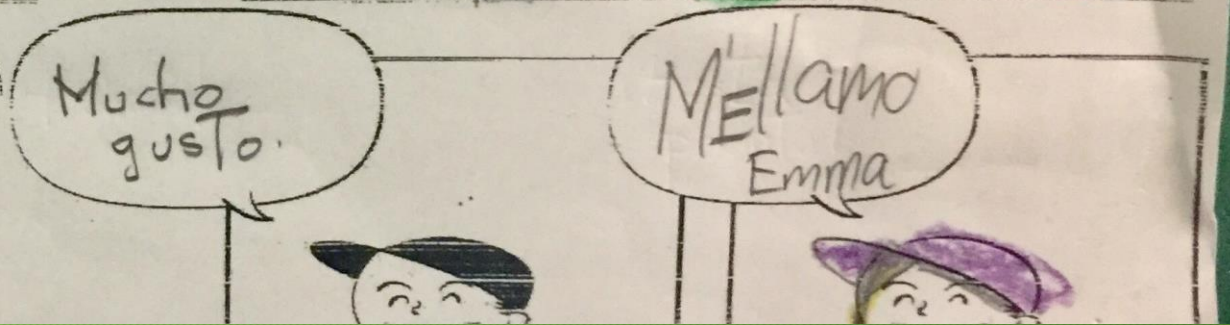
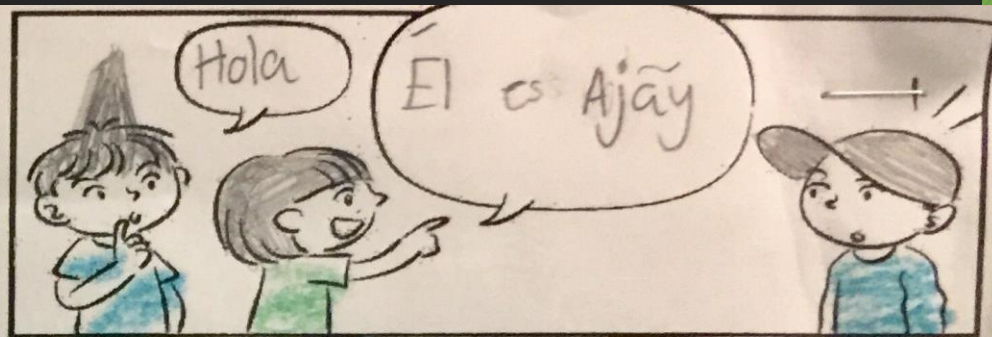

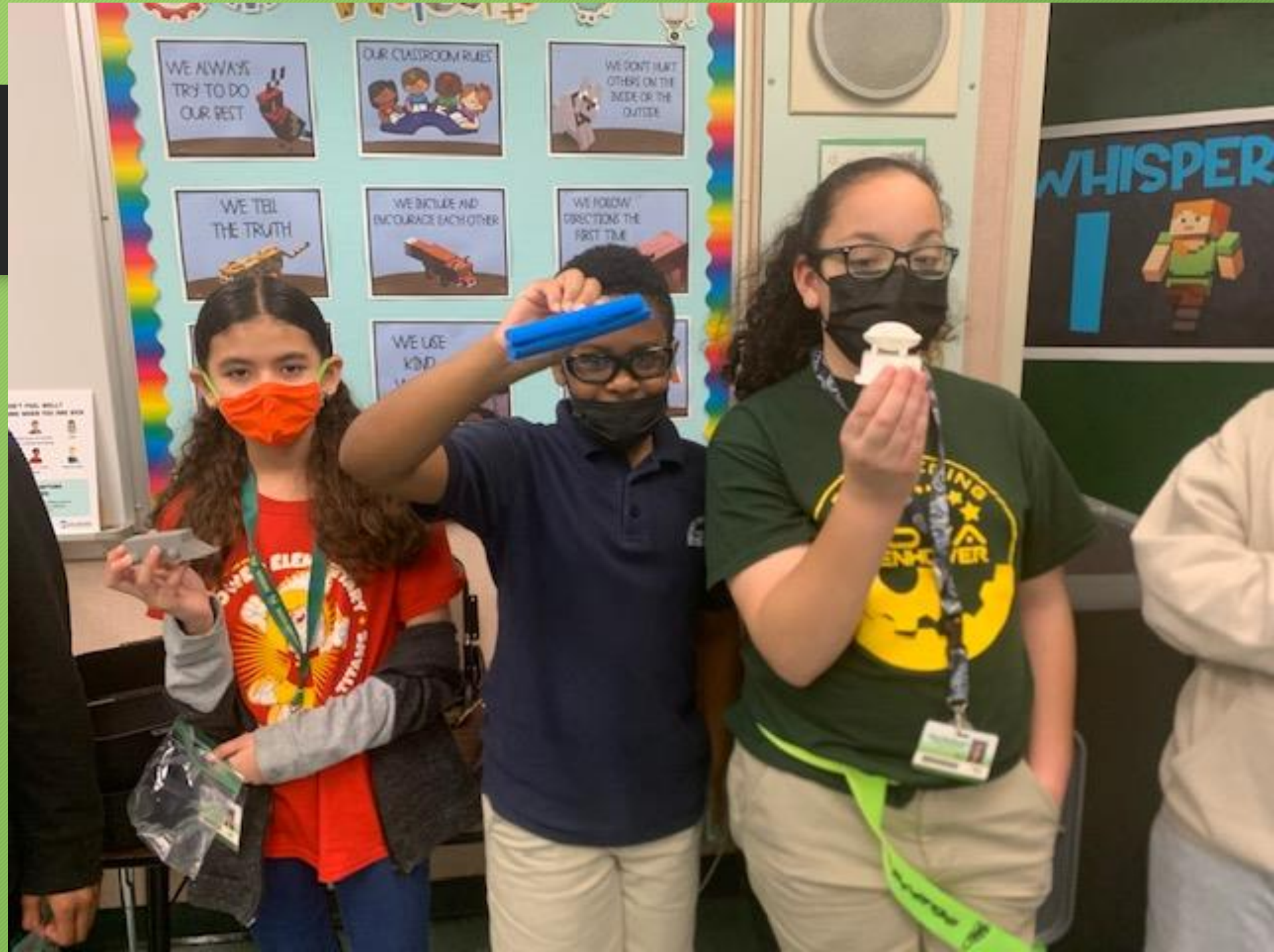
Specials has been doing coding. All students were able to participate in Hour of Code this year thanks to the specials team! They continued their practicing coding skills in computer and STEM specials.

ELA-Benchmark Advance Unit 5 How Do We Use Technology?

1st Grade



First grade continues to learn about narrators and summarizing and retelling a text. We are preparing for our Black History Month home project for February. We are also administering the BAS reading assessment to determine students' current reading levels.

2nd Grade



Math- Currently working on Subtraction with and without regrouping

Reading -Central idea and details, text features and author's purpose

Science -Just finished human body and now we're doing energy and force and motion.

Events- have a fieldtrip to IMAX Movie

We increased I-ready reading and math goals, and students are learning how to monitor their growth. We're holding them accountable.

3rd Grade



Third grade is continuing to work on Benchmark Advance in reading. We will begin our FSA practice tests in late February and plan to begin spiral review in reading then as well. We are using manipulatives for math and are learning about division and fractions. Third grade is also working on STREAM Night projects.

4th Grade



Fourth grade completed their mid year iReady diagnostic for reading and math. This quarter students are practicing to divide and learning about prime and composite numbers. In social studies and reading students are developing an understanding how the role of the government affects our lives through Unit 3 from Benchmark Advance. In writing, students are continuing to practice writing multiparagraph essay.

5TH Grade



Our fifth graders were able to go on a field trip to BizTown and experience what it was like to manage a business. They got firsthand experience in applying for a business loan, working, making a salary, and managing a personal bank account. It was definitely a life-learning experience. In reading, students are reading poetry and interpreting figurative language. In Math, they are learning to add and subtract fractions. In science, fifth grade is learning about types of energy, and in Social Studies, students are learning about influential people who have contributed to Black History.
