Reading:

i-Ready - Students follow their path for individualized instruction and practice (*Recommendation = 45 Min. a week*)

Take Accelerated Reader Tests on books read - go to ARbookfind.com to find books at your child's reading level (*Recommendation = one book a week minimum depending on the length of the book*)

Grades K-2

Read aloud to your child. It is important that your child have a model of what good reading looks like and sounds like. This is also a great role for an older sibling.

Kindergarten-review letter names and sounds

Read daily, reread familiar books

Draw a picture and write about your favorite part of the story

Discuss what you read with your family

Grades 3-5

Read chapter books (review to sites above)

Have your child write about the book: story summary, favorite character or part and why, write a review of the story

Work on writing in full sentences with correct punctuation

Take an AR quiz upon completion of book(s) read

Work on oral language skills by discussing the books you are reading with someone in your home

Math:

i-Ready Math Learning Games are the recommended resource to use over the summer. These can be accessed through your Clever by clicking the i-Ready icon or downloading the Math Learning Games App on any Apple iPad. Students can also access their i-Ready Learning Path if preferred.

- Daily Recommendation to build Math Fluency: 10-15 minutes

Upcoming 1st & 2nd Graders should play: Hungry Guppy, Hungry Fish and Match









This enforces basic number sense, addition, subtraction and multiplication

Upcoming 3rd & 4th Graders should play: Hungry Fish, Pizza, Cupcake, Bounce & Cloud Machine

This enforces addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions and word problems

Upcoming 5th Graders should play: Pizza & Cloud Machine

This enforces multiplication, division, fractions and word problems.
