We are entering a new world of digital learning... there is bound to be problems and we are sure to encounter issues along the way. While we have adequate bandwidth to operate our digital learning platform, we do anticipate that from time to time that things may be slow, or you may have trouble signing into the portal. We also anticipate limited access to Canvas on Thursday and Friday, as the district transitions into the new marking period. Please be patient as we are all learning to navigate this new reality.

This document is a shortcut to some valuable links and reminders. All the links are live so if you are viewing the document in a digital format, it will connect to the website directly. Otherwise, you will need to type in the link.

## **Information Relating to Video Conferencing Etiquette:**

If your child's teacher is using a video conference platform such as TEAMS or ZOOM, there are some important reminders to ensure that kids are safe, and we respect the right of privacy for all.

• Once your child's teacher provides the link to the conference, do not share or post the link publicly.

- While the teacher will record the meeting to share with those that can not attend, no student or parent should record or share the meeting on any social media platform.
- Parents should not photograph, or screen shot the "chat" room of a video conference. Parents can disable the video if they do not want their child's picture to show.
- If you are participating in a video conference, please remember the following:
  - Video conference time is designed for your child and the teacher. If you have questions, please email the teacher to discuss your questions. The conference is not the time to do that.
  - Please consider the background that will show on the screen during the video conference. Please take care that others cannot be seen.
  - Have your child mute their device when they are not speaking.
  - Make sure that there is a light source over or in front of your child, a light source behind your child will create a dark image and others will not be able to tell who it is on the screen.
  - Make sure your child is looking at and talking towards the camera not the screen.
  - Teachers may ask students to have supplies or materials with them during the conference, please make sure those materials are available before signing on the conference call.
  - Please understand that our teachers are managing this learning platform from their home and they also have families... that means from time to time emergencies may arise requiring the call to end earlier than anticipated. Please be patient.
