



## ***Preparing students for the 2<sup>nd</sup> I-Ready Diagnostic Assessment***

Dear Bethune Family & Friends,

It's hard to believe that we're already preparing for the second *i-Ready*<sup>®</sup> *Diagnostic*. The second Diagnostic is an important benchmark for understanding your student's growth, which is why it's so important for students to try their best. These results allow us to better support them in achieving their growth goals for the year. Students took the ELA Diagnostic on the week of December 6<sup>th</sup>. They will be taking the Math Diagnostic on the week of January 10<sup>th</sup>.

The most important thing we can do is prepare students and motivate them to put forth their best effort.

Here are a few things you can do to help support students:

- Make sure they get a good night's rest before taking the Diagnostic!
- Talk to students about why the second Diagnostic is important. You can say things like:
  - *The second Diagnostic helps you find out how much progress you've made since the beginning of the year.*
  - *It allows your teacher and I to celebrate your accomplishments!*
  - *Try your best, and do not rush—but don't spend too much time on a question either.*
  - *Remember, questions on the Diagnostic change based on your answers to earlier questions. You will see some questions you don't know. That is okay! Just try your best.*
- Let them know you're excited to celebrate their progress.
