To earn the Cambridge AICE Diploma, learners must achieve a minimum of seven courses/exams (including Cambridge International Global Perspectives) from subject groups 1, 2, and 3 (and optionally Group 4). At least one credit must come from each of Groups 1, 2 and 3. The remaining credits can come from any of the groups. A maximum of two credits can count from Group 4.
