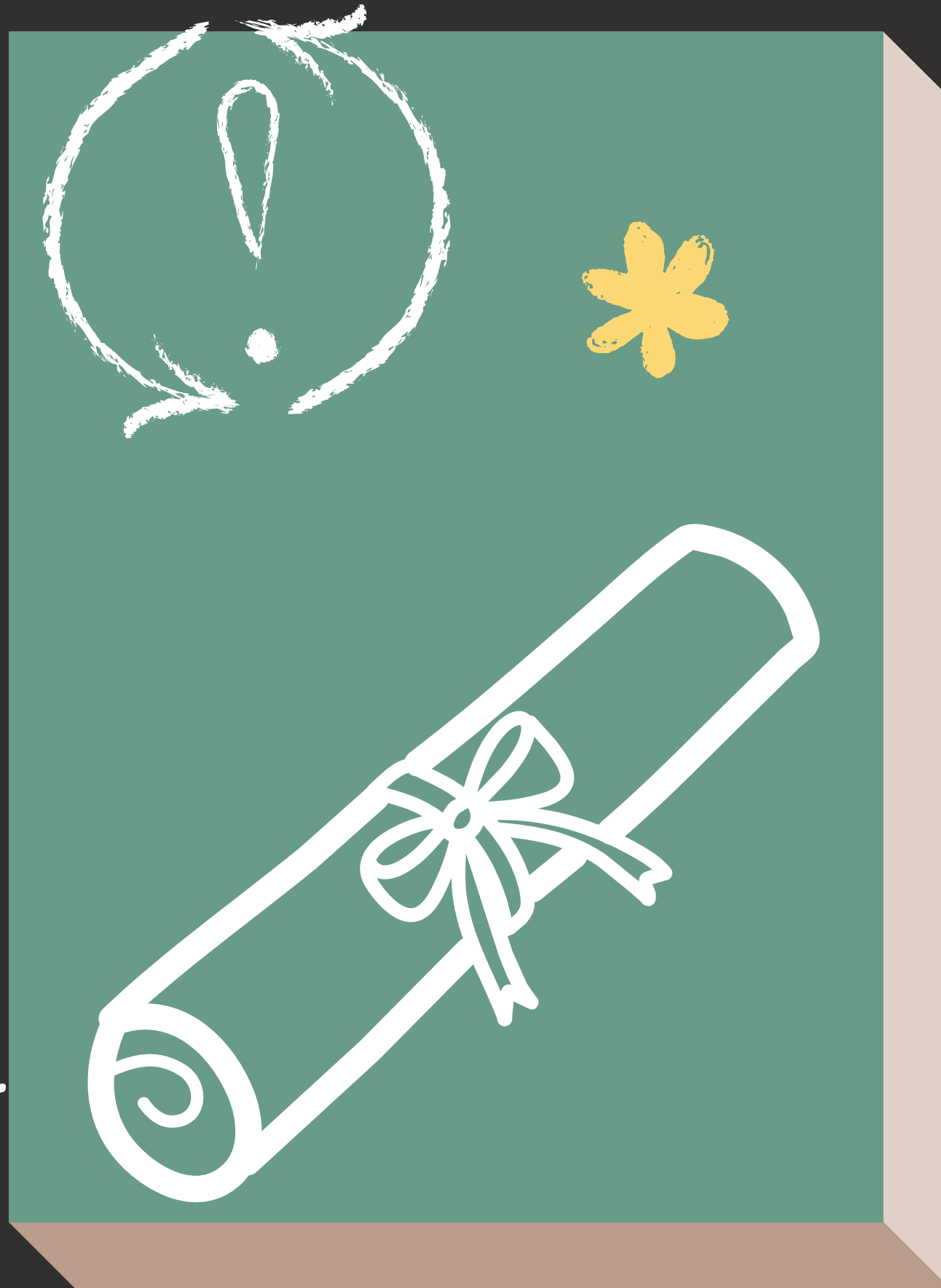




# NEW GRAD REQUIREMENT! CLASS OF 2025 & BEYOND

# DIPLOMA OPTIONS

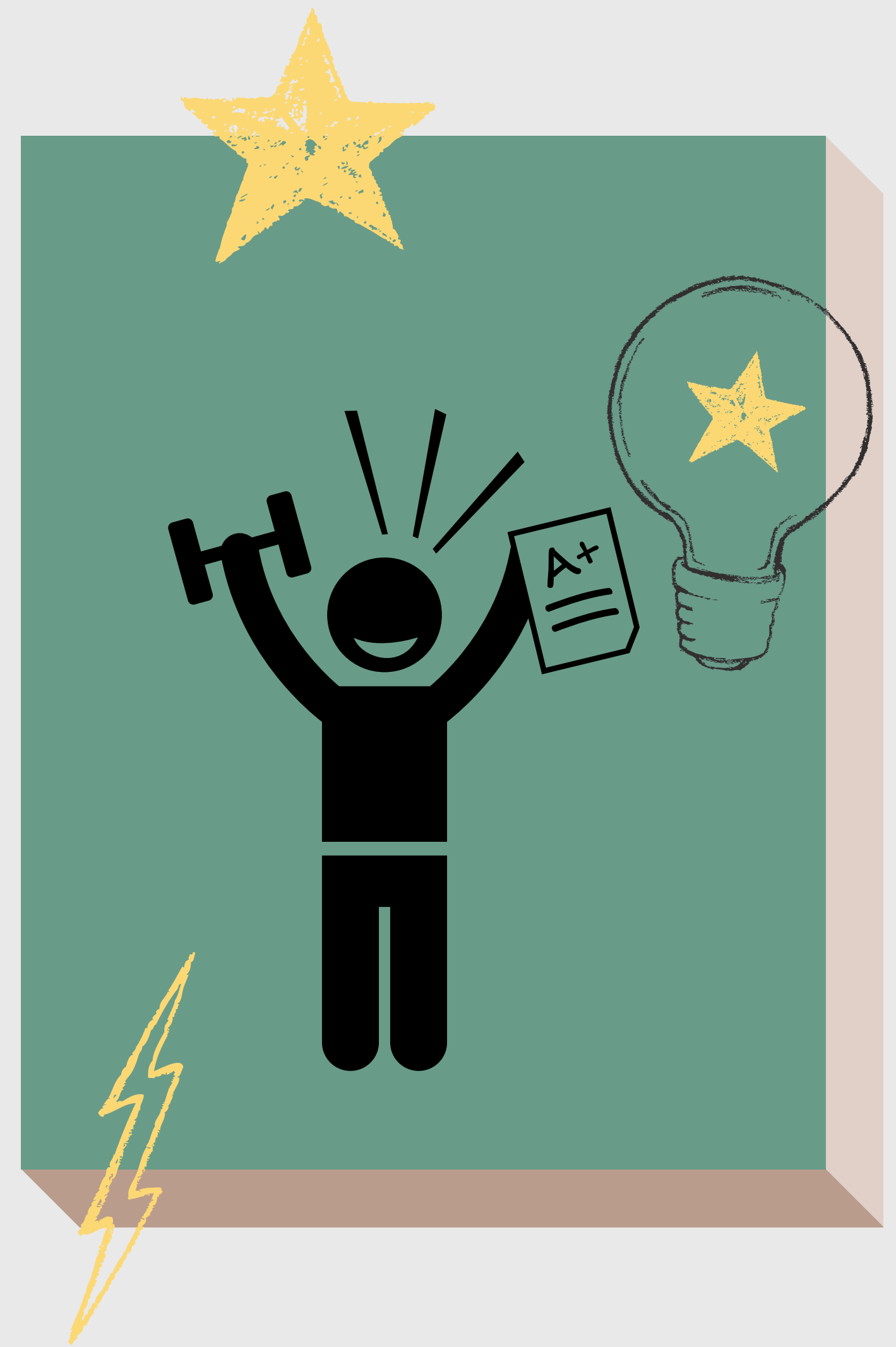
- 24 CREDIT STANDARD DIPLOMA
- ACCEL 18 CREDIT DIPLOMA

Must meet all requirements of 24 credit diploma except:

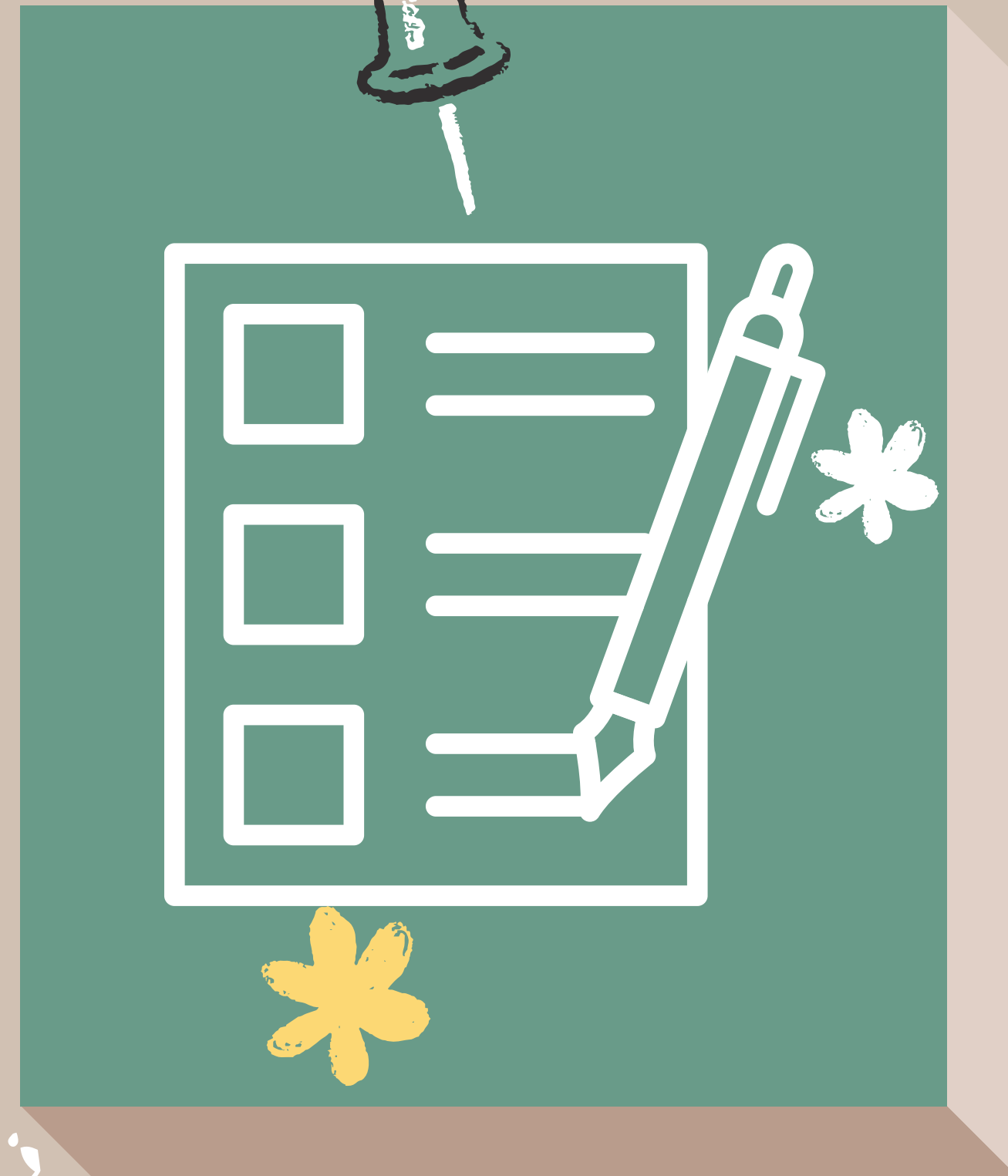
- PE not required
- Online Credit not required
- Service Hours not required
- 3 elective credits vs 8

# P.E REQUIREMENT OPTIONS

- HOPE - 1 full credit
- Personal Fitness (.5 credit) AND any P.E elective (.5 credit)
- 2 FULL Credits of JROTC (which also satisfies performing fine arts requirement)
- 2 FULL seasons of participation in a JV or Varsity Sport (waiver form must be requested)







# EOC TESTING REQUIREMENTS

- Algebra I EOC
  - must pass for graduation and 30% of final course grade
- Geometry EOC
  - could use in place of Algebra I EOC req and 30% of final course grade

- Biology EOC
- U.S History EOC

# READING CLASSES

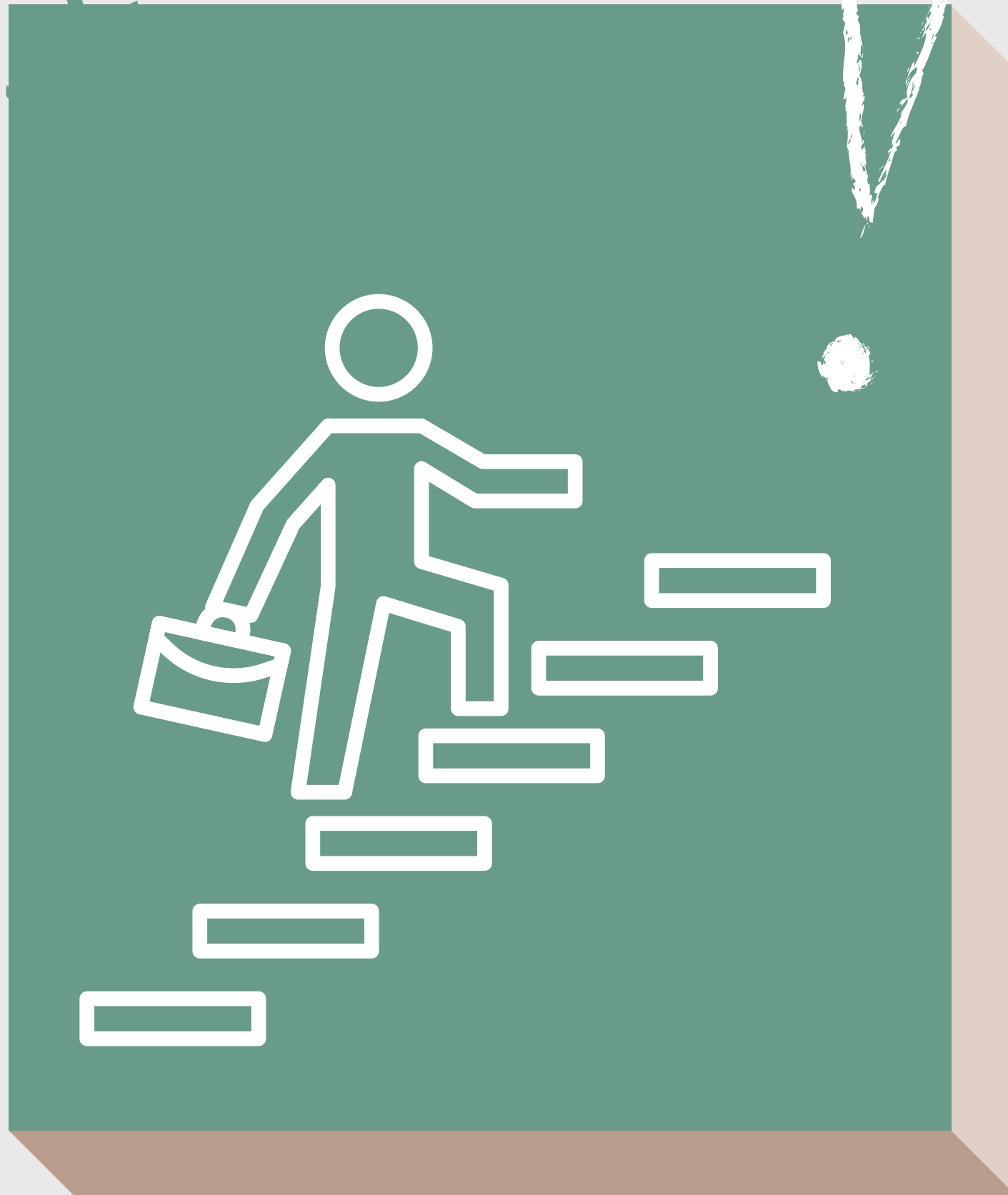
COUNTS AS AN ELECTIVE!



- If you do not pass your FAST, you will be required to take a Reading Class for the entire school year.
- The scores used to determine your classes at this time are the most recent scores available.
- Once new scores are in over the summer, enrollment in reading may be adjusted prior to the beginning of next school year.

# THE CAMBRIDGE INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM

- Take Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) courses and pass 7 exams to earn an AICE Diploma within a 3 year period
- Earn College Credits for every exam passed!
- Accepted at all colleges and universities!
- Qualify for the highest level of Bright Futures Scholarship with AICE Diploma & 100 hours of community service.
- AICE courses are weighted on a 6.0 scale.



# DUAL ENROLLMENT

## BROWARD COLLEGE



- FREE college AND high school credit
- 3.0 unweighted GPA
- qualifying test scores on SAT/ACT/Accuplacer
- All requirements/paperwork must meet semester deadlines

## EARLY ADMISSIONS @ BROWARD COLLEGE

- ONLY for Seniors!
- meet all regular dual enrollment requirements
- students take ALL courses senior year AT BC
- no schedule @ FHS, but still FHS student

## SHERIDAN TECHNICAL SCHOOL

- 11th & 12th grade
- 2.0 unweighted GPA
- many technical program options
- transportation provided to campus and back to FHS
