HLP1081 (Health Fitness)/**DEP2004** (Developmental Psychology)
9th – 12th grade

MAC1105 (College Algebra)/**STA2023** (Intro to Statistics)

*Must have completed Algebra 2 and **have qualifying math scores on placement test, no alternate methods***

ENC1101 (Composition I)/**ENC1102** (Composition II)

11th and 12th Grade

These classes are included on your Flanagan schedule and taught by Flanagan teachers! Earn up to 18 college credits for free! Classes are paired for Fall and Spring Semesters. Minimum 3.0 unweighted GPA required.

If you are new to Dual Enrollment:

1

First, you will need to submit your BC application to gain a BC ID number on broward.edu/dual under “students”

2

After you have your BC ID number, you will need to make sure you have qualifying test scores or credits under “Eligibility Requirements”

3

If you take the Accuplacer and receive passing scores, you will send the PDF download of your score report to your grade level counselor.

4

On BC’s website you will fill out your DE Recommendation Form, where you list the courses you wish to take. If taking on campus class, please note “On FHS campus” in comments.

If you have previously Dual Enrolled with Broward College, you only need to complete step 4 each semester you wish to take classes.
