



1. Homeroom

Participation is required. Each grade-level is assigned one day per week: 6th grade on Monday, 7th grade on Tuesday, and 8th grade on Wednesday from 7:15 AM – 7:40 AM. The purpose is to set the day's schedule and ensure that students know what is going on within the school and how to access the assignments. It is also a SEL break. Grades are awarded in the course based on submitted classwork.

2. School Calendar

4. Required log in steps

• Students must log in through Single Sign-On (sso.browardschools.com) every day using their Active Directory credentials:

Password: PMM/DD/YYYY

- Once they are logged in, they will select 'Canvas' from the Clever dashboard
- On the Canvas Dashboard the student will click on three vertical dots and select 'card view'.
- The courses for which the student is enrolled will appear as tiles on the dashboard.
- Students must enter each "card" to determine their assignments for the class.
- Assignments are usually posted under the "Announcements" or "Assignments" link.

- Grade 6 to Grade 7 and Grade 7 to Grade 8: MUST pass four (4) courses (2 of which must be core)
 - Schools are responsible for coding students who have not met the promotion criteria in TERMS as retained.
- Grade 8 to Grade 9: MUST pass all promotion criteria
 - 3 Language Arts
 - 3 Math
 - 3 Science
 - 3 Social Studies including Civics and career planning
