Please keep in mind that the <u>only</u> classes that our students are eligible to take would be the courses that we offer at the Western High School Campus.

REGISTRATION STEPS (Do not register on the FIU website – follow steps below)

- 1) Make sure that you have at least the minimum 3.0 unweighted GPA requirement.
- 2) Select the FIU course(s) of your choice on our Western High School Course Card.
- 3) Make sure that you have either met the testing requirements or are planning to take one of the qualifying tests. Due to Covid-19, testing opportunities may be limited. If you are currently in 10th grade and interested in taking an FIU Dual Enrollment course, you can take the school day PERT (emails will be sent later in the semester with those details) or sign up to take the SAT (www.collegeboard.org) or ACT (www.actstudent.org)
- 4) Make sure that once you have the qualifying test scores, you email them to jeffrey.poole@browardschools.com.

It is a very simple process. Once the next school year begins and see the FIU class on your schedule, your FIU professor will give you instructions on how to register for the course through the FIU website.
