  - c. Option 3: Complete 2 full years of **JROTC** Option
  - d. Option 4: Complete 2 full seasons of a Junior Varsity or Varsity Sport
- 7. It is recommended that students satisfy their Performing/Fine Arts credit as early as possible. For the best results, students should join beginning-level Performing/Fine Arts in 9th grade, so they may be placed in advanced performing classes in 10th, 11th, and 12th grade if desired.
- 8. Must select 3 Alternate Courses
- 9. Meet with a WHS Counselor to review and approve your schedule.

Give each choice careful consideration as schedule changes will not be permitted due to the Class Size Reduction Legislation and Mandate. Understand that the courses selected are for a full year.
