The safety and security of our children is paramount here at Coconut Creek Elementary. - ALL STUDENTS are required to wear their student ID DAILY and at all times when they are in school. We will be providing students with lanyards. Until photo identification badges are received from our vendor, teachers will supply a printed badge for your child. This will also serve as students' lunch cards.
- <u>Unified Dress Code- CCE has a unified dress code for all students.</u>
 - Students are expected to be in uniform daily.
 - Students' adherence to our dress code is important in helping us identify intruders on campus. For more information on approved colors and types of clothing, please see the Uniform Policy below, your child's agenda, front office display, or the CCE website.

Please be advised that we provide Before Care from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. There is a charge for
this. Aftercare is provided from 2:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily. So as to not conflict with regular
dismissal, children in <u>Aftercare may not be picked up prior to 3:00 p.m.</u> Please see the attached

- Arrival- Students may arrive in the following ways:
 - Please be advised there is no supervision of students before 8:00a.m.
 - At 8:00 a.m.-Car-lines- Students may be dropped off in the front car line (grades 1-5) or Kindergarten & ASD on the North side of campus.
 - Biker/Walker- Students will enter through the front Pedestrian Gate, use the designated sidewalk and access the bike rack if needed.
 - Bus Rider- Students arrive to school on a bus and proceed to breakfast or their classroom.

NEW! All parents of bus riders must register their children to ride the bus via Register to Ride (R2R). Please find information and registration links below. - Dismissal- Please be advised the front parking lot and Kindergarten side will not open until 2:20 p.m.
 - Any student who walks MUST be dismissed as a walker from the front of the school.
 - Bus Riders will be escorted from their classrooms to the bus area.
 - Coconut Creek Aftercare students will be dismissed from the classrooms to their counselors.
- Dismissal Definitions:
 - Car Riders:
 - Please stay in your car.
 - Note: <u>Parents of children listed as Car Riders</u> will not be permitted to park on the swale and stand on the sidewalk in front of the school and wait for dismissal.
- Walkers/Bike Riders (front of school):
- Students will be brought to the front Pedestrian Gates. North Walkers will follow the sidewalk and it will lead to the Crossing Guard on 45th Avenue and Coconut Creek Blvd. South Walkers will be initially crossed in front of Bus Exit by Officer Grieve, and then will proceed to the Crossing Guard.
- Walkers will be dismissed from the front Pedestrian Gates. If you would like your child to be dismissed from the Pedestrian Gate(s), your child must be listed as a Walker.
- o Late Arrival and Early Dismissal
- Students who arrive at school after 8:30 a.m. will require the parent to park and sign the child in.
- Early dismissal of students must occur by 2:00 p.m. Per school board policy, all early dismissals must occur 30 minutes prior to our regular dismissal time.
- All perimeter gates will be locked once the school day has started at 8:30 a.m., until 2:20 p.m. Throughout the day, if you need to enter the building, you will need to call the front office at 754-322-5800 and have a photo ID ready to present.

Severe Weather Dismissal Procedures

• During the school year, we may experience days of sudden thunderstorms at dismissal time. Students (other than car riders) are encouraged to have a poncho in their backpacks. In case of torrential rain and lightning, student dismissal may change. If your child is a walker or bike rider, please instruct them as to the procedure they are to follow, i.e., if they will become a Car Rider. A Parentlink will be sent to alert you of the Rainy Day/Lightning Alert. If it is necessary to change your child's dismissal on rainy days, please specify the procedures your child/children should follow in case of a rainy-day dismissal and inform their teachers.

Coconut Creek Elementary Unified Dress Code

- 1. **Bottoms:** (mid-thigh length or longer)
 - a. shorts, capri pants, pants, skirts or skorts
 - b. Colors: khaki, black, or navy blue

2. Tops with or without logos:

- a. long or short sleeves, **collared** polo style and crew neck cotton shirts with or without the school logo and approved school spirit shirts
- b. Colors: (solid) white, light blue, gray, yellow, maroon, and gold

3. Footwear:

- a. sneakers preferred
- b. backless and open toed footwear are not allowed

Please note that on Fridays we celebrate "School Spirit Day". Your child may wear jeans, (shorts or pants) with a Coconut Creek spirit Day T-shirt, (Purchased through PTA at https://ccespta.memberhub.com/store) If your child does not have a Coconut Creek Spirit Day T-Shirt, he or she must wear a regular uniform shirt.

Students should NOT wear:

- Tank tops
- Midriff tops
- Spaghetti straps
- Backless shirts
- Lycra or spandex
- Gym or drawstring shorts

Consequences for violations are as follows:

Violation #1: Letter will be sent home

Violation #2: Letter will be sent home and student is sent to uniform closet to change. If

item is unavailable, parent will be contacted.

<u>Violation #3+</u>: Letter will be sent home and parent is contacted to bring student a change

of clothes.
