## Attendance Messaging

The messages below may be embedded in your school's routine ParentLink updates to parents. Many schools send weekly or bi-weekly messages to parents to update the community about upcoming events and school functions. These brief statements are intended to remind parents (K-12) that regular attendance is a key component to academic success. A variety of messages are included for you to choose from throughout the school year.

Attendance Counts! General messages promoting regular attendance.		
1	Good attendance helps all students do well in school and sends a message that their education is important to their future. Attendance Counts! All day, every school day!	
2	Reducing chronic absenteeism is essential to ensuring student success. We need your support. At <our name="" school=""> our goal is to encourage all students to be in school every school day. <b>Attendance Counts!</b></our>

1	Parents have been asking for an easier way to report an absence. Our school has an online form that parents can fill out and get a confirmation of the information you share with our school. Visit our school website, go to "Contacts" and select "Report an Absence" for more information. Attendance Counts! All day, every school day!	
2	Together, we can improve student attendance and achievement by pledging to ensure your child attends school every school day he or she is healthy. If your child must be absent, please report the reason within two days. You can report an excused absence by phone, a written note, or the new online form on our website. Visit our school website, go to "Contacts" and select "Report an Absence" for more information. Attendance Counts! All day, every school day!	
3	To report an excused absence for your child, visit our website – go to "Contacts" and select "Report an Absence" using our online form. You can also call the attendance hotline or bring a written note. Attendance Counts! All day, every school day!	
4	If your child is absent, remember to report the reason within two days to help us reduce unexcused absences and increase student achievement. Attendance Counts! All day, every school day!	
5	We want our students in school each school day. If your child must be absent, report the reason for an excused absence by phone, note, or by using the online form on our website. Visit our website- go to "Contacts" and select "Report an Absence. Attendance Counts! All day, every school day!
