## Grab-and-Go Meals Available for New School Year

When eLearning begins on Wednesday, August 19, Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) will make grab-and-go meals available for students at elementary, middle and high school locations throughout the District.

The first week of school, meals will be available on Wednesday, August 19, and Thursday, August 20, from 11 a.m. – 1 p.m. and from 3 – 5 p.m. The weeks following, meals will be distributed on Tuesdays and Thursdays, at the same times, in bundles that include multiple days-worth of meals. The afternoon hours were added to provide greater convenience for parents assisting their students with eLearning during the morning hours.

BCPS will follow the National School Lunch Program, which requires BCPS-enrolled students to receive meals based on their eligibility status: free, reduced or paid. Through the Universal Free Breakfast program, all BCPS-enrolled students can receive free breakfast no charge.

The cost for meals is as follows:

Adults and non-BCPS-enrolled students can purchase breakfast at \$1.80 per day and lunch at \$2.75 per day.

Families are encouraged to pay for meals prior to proceeding through the drive-thru or walk-up line to maintain the flow of the distribution process. Funds can be added to your student’s account at [www.myschoolbucks.com](http://www.myschoolbucks.com). Meals are distributed in bundles and are not available for individual purchase.

As cars pull forward, each student is required to provide his or her name and student number for the meals to be recorded on the student’s account. Parents may pick up meals for their students by presenting identification for the student, such as the school identification badge, report card, birth certificate or passport. Identification must be presented at each meal distribution.
