Removing Barriers Mural Contest

Official Contest Rules

Important: Please read these rules before entering this contest. By participating in the *Removing Barriers Mural Contest* or otherwise submitting any content (as defined below), you agree to be bound by these Official Contest Rules.

Who May Enter?

Removing Barriers Mural Contest is open to Coral Springs High School students *only* (9-12). Recognition of Mural designs will only be credited to Coral Springs High School students. Students may work as a group (**no more than 5 persons**) or individually.

What are the Submission Guidelines?

- Each submission must include an original mural design competition piece on 8.5x11 paper that creates an artistic narrative around the theme of bringing awareness to the societal and/or systemic barriers that impede growth socially, economically, systemically, etc. (ex. classism, hatred, etc.). Your design should be for a painted mural.
- Each submission must include a brief typed description on 8.5x11 paper about your design that does not exceed 250 words.
- Each submission must be appropriate for *any* school environment.



What are the Content Restrictions?

- One submission based on theme, per student/group.
- Your submission must not include identifiable person or persons (i.e. other students) unless you have received a written consent for use of their image/likeness. Failure to provide proof of consent will lead to automatic disqualification from the contest.
- Your submission, official entry and final artwork must not contain material that violates or infringes another's rights. It must not contain material that is inappropriate, indecent, obscene, hateful, tortuous, defamatory, slanderous or libelous.



- Each submission, official entry and final artwork must not contain material that promotes bigotry, racism, hatred or harm against any group or individual or promotes discrimination based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation or age.

What is the Time Frame for Entry?

The Contest will open on **Monday, November 2, 2020 at 7:40 am** and close on **Friday, November 20, 2020 at 3:10pm**.
The winner(s) of the contest will receive official notice by Tuesday, December 1, 2020 via a Microsoft Teams call.

What Formats are Acceptable for Submission?

Submissions may be digital or hardcopy. Touchless hardcopy submissions will be accepted in the front office in a designated area. All hard copy submissions will be subject to misting sanitization. All submissions must include the writable Mural Scoring Rubric with all persons included on the project named.

The panel will be judging the following categories (please review official contest rubric **before** entering): *Creativity, Understanding and Representation of Theme and Subject Matter, School-Friendly Content, and Critical Thinking/Thought-Provoking Artistry.*

What is the Prize?

The winner(s) will have his/her artwork displayed as a painted mural in a designated place on the campus of Coral Springs High School. There will be a grand reveal of the mural to our entire school community.
