

Cooper City High School Profile - Class of 2021

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School

Cooper City High School (CCHS) is located in Cooper City, FL and is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. CCHS is a comprehensive public school, nationally acclaimed as a Blue Ribbon School and recognized as one of America's Best High Schools by *US News & World Report*, and recognized as a designated Florida School of Excellence by the FLDOE. Moreover, the school has been recognized by Broward County Public Schools for its 98% graduation rate – one of the highest in the county – 49% were Honor Grads 94% of seniors had college post-secondary plans. CCHS has 2357 students, grades 9 through 12, with a culturally diverse population: 46% White, 36% Hispanic/Latino, 8% Black, 6% Asian and 4% Multi-racial or Other. Cooper City High School offers 21 Advanced Placement classes as well as 52 honors classes, in addition to 17 AICE Cambridge courses. Students also earn Industry Certifications through Career and Technical education courses. Advanced Placement, AICE and Dual Enrollment

In 2021, 515 CCHS students took over 863 AP tests in 28 subjects, and 62% scored 3 or higher. Also, 8 students received an AP Capstone Diploma, and 14 students received AICE Diplomas. In 2021, 714 CCHS students took over 1,357 AICE tests, with 84% passing their Cambridge Exam. In 2021, 298 students took Dual Enrollment courses and 48 students were Early Admission students at Broward College and University of Florida.

Weighting of Grades

All subjects are given grades and credit. Grades in courses which are labeled Honors, AICE, Advanced Placement or Dual Enrollment receive extra quality points when students earn a "C" or better. The school district determines class rank based upon the weighted GPA that is officially recalculated each semester.
