Gifted Classes

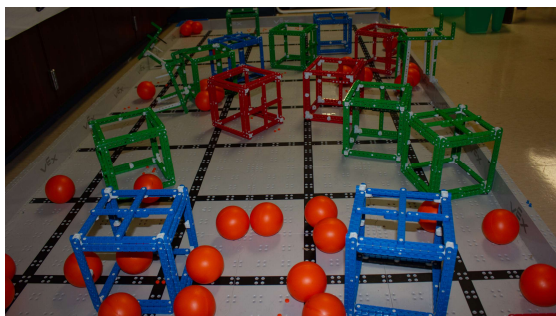
We have gifted services in grades K through 5 with self-contained classes in grades 1 through 5. Students eligible for gifted services will be provided with a personalized education plan. Our teachers and staff are highly trained in providing a challenging and appropriate curriculum to meet your child's academic and social needs.

ACCEL

All students have the opportunity to participate in accelerated instruction in math (ACCEL). Eligibility testing is conducted at the beginning of the school year to determine placement. Heron Heights is proud to have one of the highest number of participating elementary students in ACCEL across Broward County Public Schools.

Student Activities & Clubs

Heron Heights Elementary has in-house clubs including debate, chorus, safety patrol, and student council. We also offer enrichment clubs at various times of the year through an outside company which includes activities like cooking, drones, Legos and Cricut.



Multiyear Classes

Heron Heights offers multiyear classes from Kindergarten through 3rd grade. Multiyear classes are created when children from the same grade level stay with the same teacher for two consecutive years to realize academic and social benefits. Multiyear classes are an option for HHE families, who may choose between multiyear and a traditional classroom.
