Academics

Gifted Classes

We have gifted services in grades K through 5 with self-contained classes in grades 1 through 5. Students eligible for gifted services will be provided with a personalized education plan. Our teachers and staff are highly trained in providing a challenging and appropriate curriculum to meet your child's academic and social needs.

ACCEL

All students have the opportunity to participate in accelerated instruction in math (ACCEL). Eligibility testing is conducted at the beginning of the school year to determine placement. Heron Heights is proud to have the greatest number of students participating in ACCEL across Broward County Public Elementary Schools.

Student Activities & Clubs

Academic clubs at Heron Heights Elementary include debate, math, and robotics. We also have competitive math teams in grades 4 and 5 who compete in the annual BCCTM competition. We also offer chorus and color guard. In 5th grade, it is an honor and a privilege to be invited to join our team of safety patrols or morning news crew.



Multiage Program

Heron Heights offers K/1 and 2/3 multiage classes. Multiage classes are created when children of different ages and grade levels are intentionally combined in a single classroom to realize academic and social benefits.
