Students must be able to show they have been accepted and are planning on attending an HBCU. Scholarship holders must show they are a student in good standing with their university and must maintain at least a 2.75 GPA in each semester. Must be a US Citizen or Permanent Resident.	Opens January 1st

Child or step-child of one of an Active duty, Reserve, or veteran* U.S. Marine, a Marine killed while serving in the U.S. Marine Corps, Active duty, reserve, or veteran U.S. Navy Corpsman, Navy Chaplain or Religious Program Specialist who is or was attached to a U.S. Marine Corps unit or who was killed while serving with a U.S. Marine Corps unit. Authors must be students enrolled in senior high school (generally, ages 14-19) on Wednesday, January 8, 2025 in order to apply. All pieces must be submitted in English or ASL. Can be either an individual or co-author. Co-authorships of up to two students are accepted, but both authors must fulfill eligibility requirements and at least one must be a student with a disability. Co-authors do not have to be in the same grade level. The application must include information for both authors.	January 8 2025

Must earn and maintain a minimum 3.2 grade point average on a 4.0 scale. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or U.S. nationals.	January 31 2025
Union Plus Scholarships <u>Click Here!</u>	\$500 - \$4,000	Open to: Current and retired members of participating unions, their spouses and their dependent children (as defined by IRS regulations). At least one year of continuous union membership by the applicant, applicant's spouse or parent (if applicant is a dependent). The one-year membership minimum must be satisfied by May 31 of the scholarship year. Applicants are evaluated according to academic ability, social awareness, financial need and appreciation of labor. A GPA of 3.0 or higher is recommended.	January 31 2025

Pursue studies in a pertinent chemical and engineering industry STEM field. Attend an HBCU for the entirety of their college education. Have interest in pursuing a career in chemical manufacturing, engineering, environmental health and sustainability or other related chemical-industry fields. Demonstrate financial need. Be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.	January 31 2025
