As we are quickly approaching Florida Standard Assessment (FSA) Reading and Math there are some things you can be working on at home. Fsassessments.org is a wonderful website that has free reading and math practice. Since reading is paper based, you can print out the test and practice a few questions each day. The math practice can be done on the paper to prep for the computer-based test. As a team we will send home optional practice that you can use to help review standards over spring break as well.

Other great resources to help practice and become proficient in the standards are Ten Marks, I-Ready, and Xtra Math. Please continue to practice the multiplication

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facts with your students. We will be having a multiplication competition and any practice will benefit your student!

As we are approaching Spring Break, our fabulous fourth graders have been hard at work trying to master their standards from the Broward Standard Assessment. Our students are owning their data as it is displayed in the classroom for them to observe on a daily basis. We are super proud of how hard each and every student is working.
