- The PSAT 10 will be administered at Stranahan High School on: **Wednesday, October 13, 2021 at 7:40 a.m.**
- All Freshman (9th Grade) and Sophomores (10th Grade) are registered by Broward County Public Schools for the October 13, 2021 PSAT 10. This test is offered free to both 9th and 10th grade students.
- The PSAT 10 provides a concordant score for students who have not met their Algebra 1 Graduation requirement. A score of 430 on the math section of the PSAT 10/ NMSQT satisfies the Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement.
- The PSAT 10 is a great practice test for the SAT. In mid-December, College Board releases the PSAT NMSQT scores. Students can log into their College Board account for a detailed score report. This enables the student to review their strengths and weaknesses so they can better prepare for the SAT.

- There are 2 Math sections on the PSAT 10/ NMSQT
 - One section does NOT allow calculators
 - The other section does. All scientific calculators can be used on this section; some graphing calculators are permitted.

 - Students are responsible for bringing an “approved” calculator to testing.
- On test day students should bring a College Board approved calculator, 2 pencils, a jacket, a snack and drink.
- PSAT results are entered in to Khan Academy by College Board. Using your student's PSAT results Khan Academy develops customized SAT tutoring that reinforces the student's strengths and remediates the student's weaknesses.
