

- ♦ **Picture Day is August 31st!


Uniform Policy and IDs

Shoes: Sneakers or Closed-in shoes only (No Sandals, Slippers, Crocs or Slides)









What is Pinnacle?

Broward County Public Schools has implemented a grade book system called *Pinnacle* in all schools. This allows you to access your child's grades in each class via the Internet.


