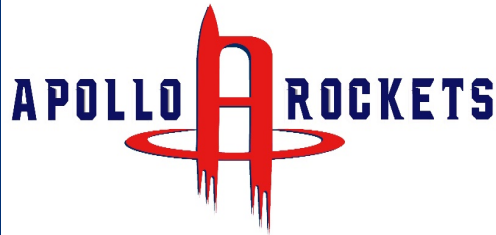

Apollo's Cross County Track team made it to the Championships again this year!



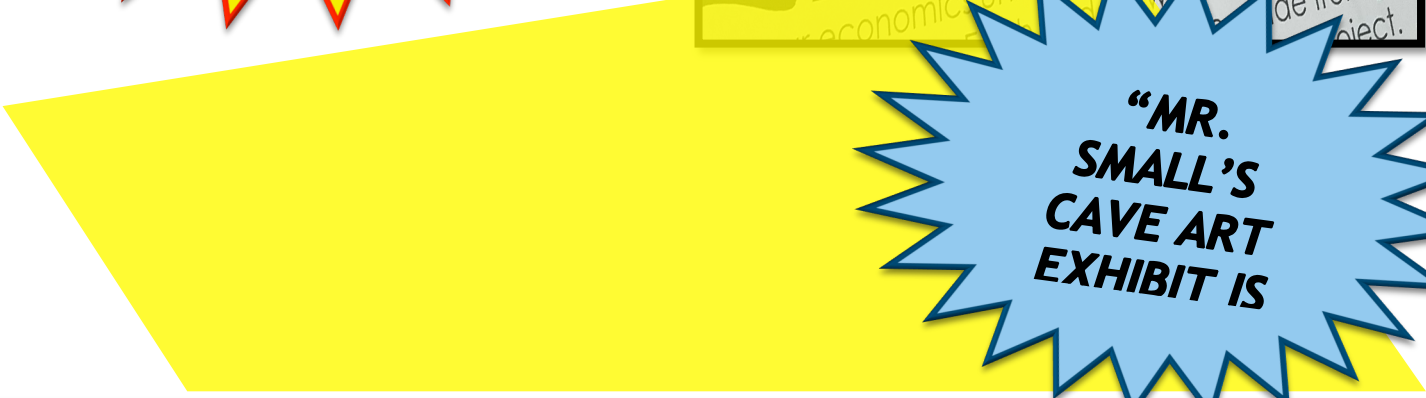
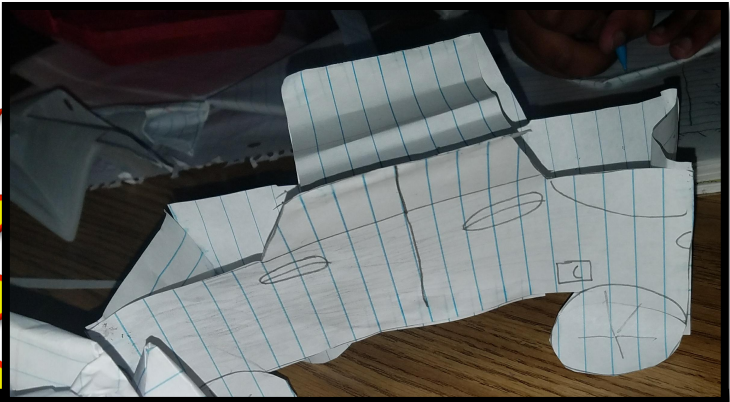
