FAST Results
ELA Gr. 3-5 (results and the testing system is new and not adaptive).
We are figuring out proficiencies because that is what will be looked at. Test is all about proficiencies. Data from beginning of year, students not exposed to standards yet. About 40% in a good zone for ELA results, 57% in red but great instruction is happening. Math results (what will look for PM2) We are going to measure benchmark in number sense and operations.
ELA has cycles that build on, have supports set in place for those students. Just this year, it will be based on proficiencies in grade 3-5.
 - c. School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) / Behavior Update – Mr. LaPlante
 - SESIR Data: 4 total incidents reported
Some are still going through the process to see if there is all SESIR.
Vaping Situation that is under SESIR.
2 threats, 1 fight (hit both ways), & 1 vape situation.
Threats still happening – need to review with parents and staff and students what is appropriate.
New Threat Assessment Department with a leader to use a support and reviews each assessment.
