



Tips for Students During eLearning

Familiarize Yourself with Online Learning Practices and Expectations. Teachers will review with students how to navigate the Canvas pages to show you where the assignments are located, due dates are posted, and other important announcements and features.

<u>Create a dedicated work area.</u> Whether it's a desk, or the dining room table, create a space to associate with school work, and disassociate from your home and the distractions like televisions, video games, or cellphones.

Start on track and stay on track. It's always better to be ahead than to be struggling at the last minute! Break down big projects into small, manageable parts—and give each one a deadline.

Advocate for yourself. Advocate for yourself means to make sure your needs are met. Ask your teachers questions when you do not understand directions, due dates, or even how to solve a problem. If you do not understand something that the teacher has talked about, make it your responsibility to reach out for help.
