

**Parent Information:**

This week we recognized 39 students for their work in ST Math this year with certificates and top performers received prize packets. We are excited to offer a summer competition in which students have the opportunity to win a field trip for all participants.

**ST Math** is a researched based program that promotes spatial-temporal growth. It promotes critical thinking that crosses to all subject areas. Students have used **ST Math** all school year. Students complete a “puzzle” each time they successfully move “Jiji” the penguin across the screen – which usually takes less than a minute. The goal is to complete 40 puzzles a week for 9 weeks to reach 360° of summer.

The **ST Math** 360° of summer challenge officially started June 6th! Tracking calendars were made available to students in school and have been placed on the website.

Your children should start individual challenges with their friends across the grade levels to win prizes while engaging with math over the summer.
