Exam Exemptions - Available to students on **Wednesday, May 24th** and due to be submitted by **Wednesday, May 31st** to 8th period teacher. No late forms will be accepted. Teachers will review Quarter 4 grades and the accuracy of exam exemption forms submitted. Students are to check Pinnacle on Friday, June 2nd to determine the status of exams exempted. Exams may not be administered prior to scheduled date.

As per School Board Policy 6000.1, students who have earned a grade of a “B” or better in a high school course may be exempt from up to 3 finals in a semester.

Note: * Students taking EOC assessment courses (Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology or U.S. History) will not need to exempt the FINAL Exam, as there is no FINAL Exam for those courses. Therefore, these do not count as part of the 3 allowable exemptions. Students will take the EOC assessment in lieu of a Final Exam. The statewide, standardized EOC assessment cannot be exempted.

**Students taking EOC assessment courses (Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology or U.S. History) do not get issued a semester grade in those courses. A final grade in the EOC course will be issued once the course has been completed AND the EOC exam results have been received.

Per Emergency Order 2021-EO-02 Guidance

End-of-Course 30% criteria is waived. EOC (Algebra, Geometry, Biology, US History) exam scores are expected to be released by July 31st. The calculation for the 30% final grade will come from the calculation outlined below:

- a. If the student earns a minimum grade of a C in the 4th quarter, then the EOC exam grade, which is 30% of the final grade, will be calculated by using the highest letter grade of the four quarters.
- b. If the student does not earn a minimum grade of a C in the 4th quarter, then the EOC exam grade, which is 30% of the final grade, will be calculated by using the higher of the 3rd or 4th quarter letter grade.

Exempting exams is a reward for satisfactory or better academic progress. It is widely recognized that students benefit from the study skills practiced when preparing for semester exams similar to those used in post-secondary schools. Students who choose to exempt their exams may forego the opportunity to improve their semester grades by taking their exams and earning higher grades. Even when eligible, students have the option not to use the exam exemption.

You may select up to 3 exams you qualify for and choose to exempt. Please choose wisely. If you have chosen to exempt an exam, but your current quarter grade falls below a “B”, it is your responsibility to then study for and be present for the exam. You would no longer be able to exempt the exam. If your 4th quarter grade falls below a "B" in a course and your exemption is withdrawn you will NOT be able to replace this exemption with another exemption from another class after the form has been turned in because of tests, quizzes, or assignments that were given after the exemption was approved. It is the responsibility of the student to:

- 1) Obtain Parent and Student e-signatures on the Exam Exemption Form.
- 2) Submit this exam exemption form by 2:40 pm on Wednesday, May 31, 2023. NO late forms will be accepted.
- 3) Verify with each teacher that you are still approved to exempt his/her exam and that your grade for the current quarter has not fallen below a “B” by checking Pinnacle for an "EE" in the attendance column on Friday, June 2, 2023, 3:00 pm.

Only ONE Exam Exemption Form can be submitted per student. If a student turns in a duplicate exam exemption form both forms will be considered null and void. Exams cannot be retroactively exempted once the student takes the exam. All exam exemptions require parent permission.

No exam exemptions will be granted without the required form being completed, e-signed, and turned in before the deadline. This is the student's responsibility. Failure to abide by this policy will result in the student having to take the exams for all classes.


Any newly enrolled student who must pass the 4th quarter and the exam to earn credit.
Chart below is to be used to calculate only **grades for students exempting their exams**

If a student's grade for the current quarter FALLS BELOW a "B" the student must take the exam. It is the student's responsibility to keep up with the current quarter grade. Please review with your students prior to the exam.

No exam exemptions will be granted without the required form being completed and submitted by the deadline.

Failure to abide by this policy will result in the student having to take the exams for all of their classes.
