## Daily Health Screening.

In order to enter Broward County Public Schools facilities, all individuals should answer the following self-assessment questions at home each morning prior to departure:

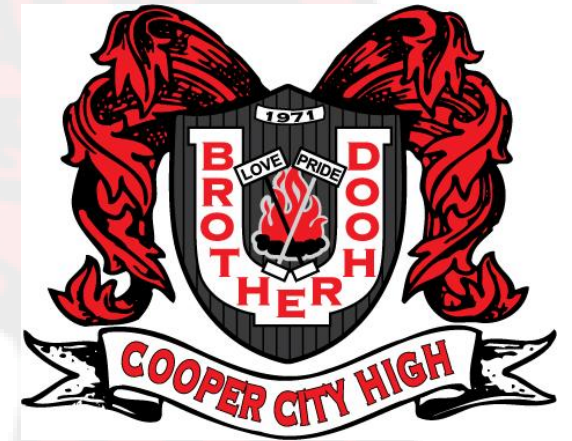
- Do I feel warm, have a fever or elevated temperature (100.4), or have the chills?
- Do I have a persistent cough, runny nose or sore throat?
- Have I recently had a loss of taste or smell?
- Has anyone in my household tested positive for COVID-19?
- Have I been in close, unprotected contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 (spent longer than 15 minutes within 6 feet of someone who was sick with a fever and cough or confirmed/suspected of having COVID-19?)
- Am I feeling otherwise sick or ill today?
- Am I awaiting test results for COVID-19?
- Have I tested positive for COVID-19?
- Have I been told to self-quarantine or self-isolate by a doctor or District administrator?

**If you can answer "NO" to all of these questions, you may proceed to school or work.**

# SAFETY & HEALTH

- Posters have been placed around campus for reminders about physical distancing, wearing masks and hand-washing
- Classrooms have been set up to adhere to physical distancing guidelines
- Students are to wash hands and sanitize their hands several times daily
- Air filters have been replaced in our HVAC system
- An isolation room has been added to quarantine any student exhibiting flu like symptoms

# ARRIVAL

7:00 am—Campus opens for students

Students exit busses one by one in a single file line

Enter campus through the North Tunnel

If the student is getting breakfast...

- Enter the Café through the East entrance closest to the North Tunnel
- Follow the arrows and directional signs to the line
- Pick up grab and go breakfast
- Only when students are seated at a desk in the café or a table in the courtyard, where the “X” is, may they take their masks to eat and drink
- Exit the Café through the South doors to the courtyard

# STUDENT ID'S & MASKS

## ID's

- Students must wear their ID on a lanyard at all times
- Students can wear last year's ID if they do not have a current ID and we will organize for them to receive a new ID during their personalization class
- If a student loses their ID, the first 4 replacements are free

- This rule must be followed without exception

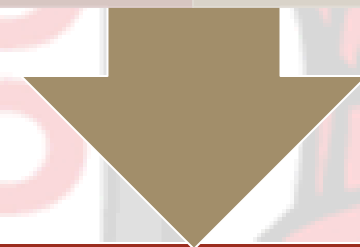

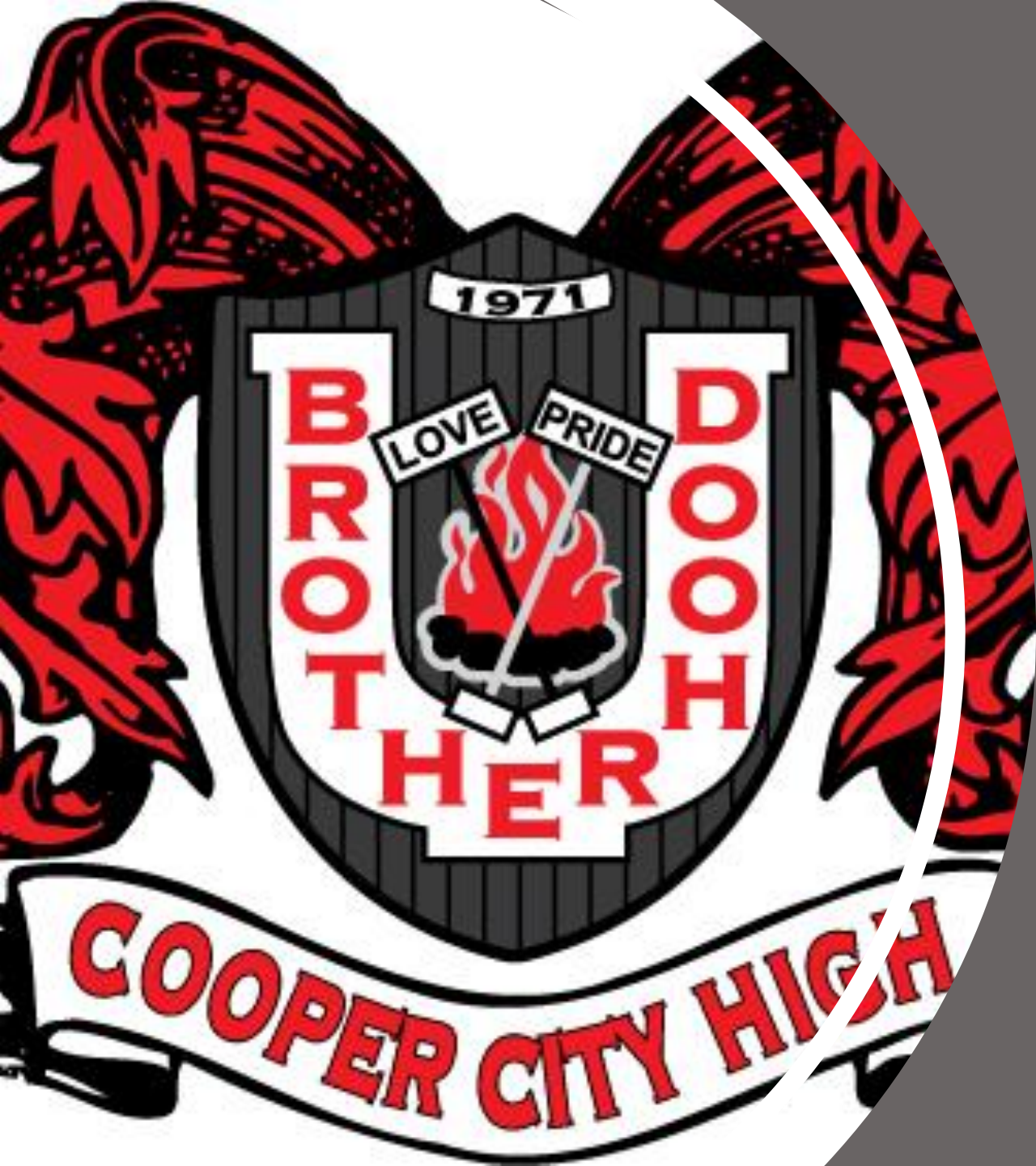

# MAP & TRAFFIC PATTERS

- Stay 6 feet apart with no congregating



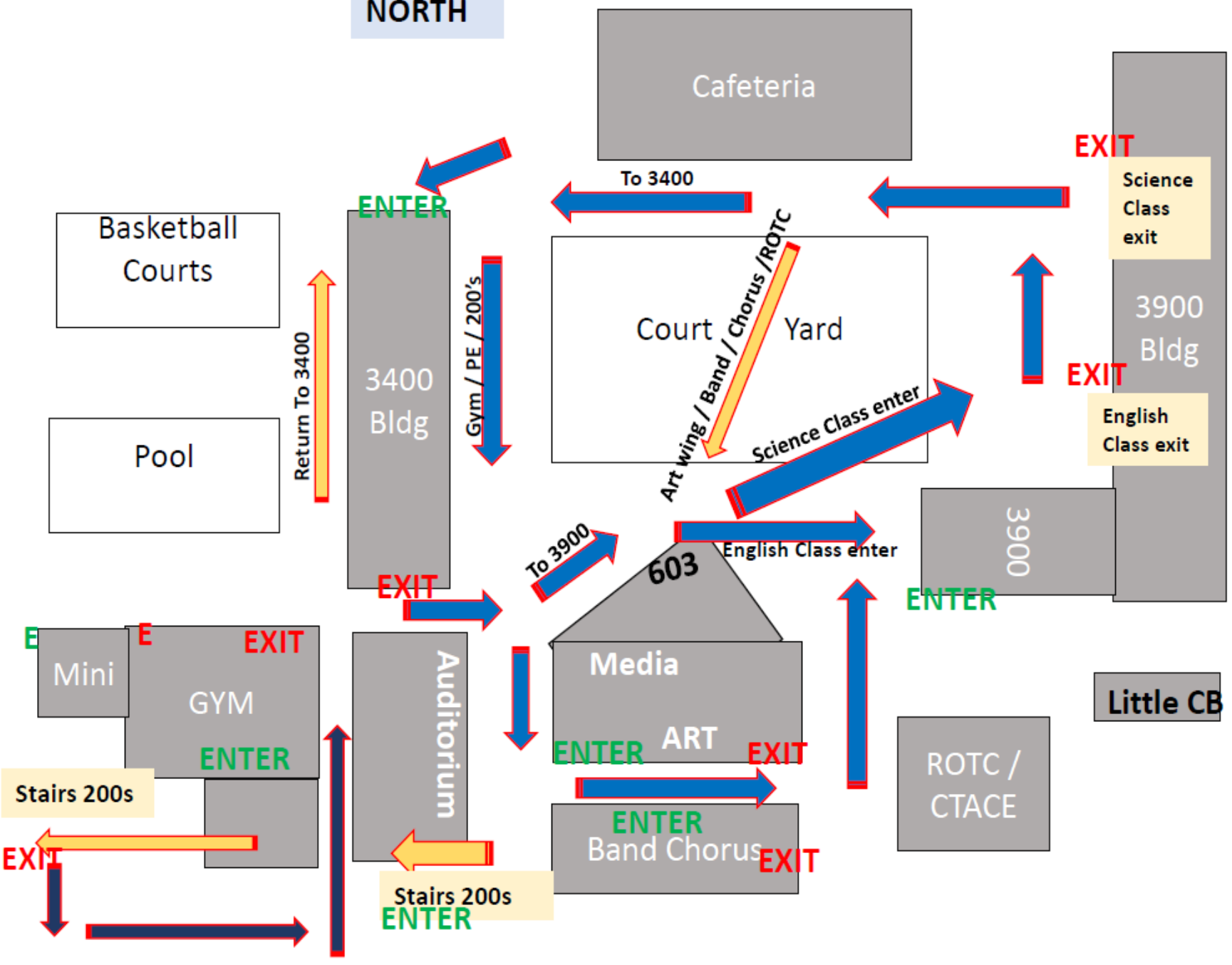
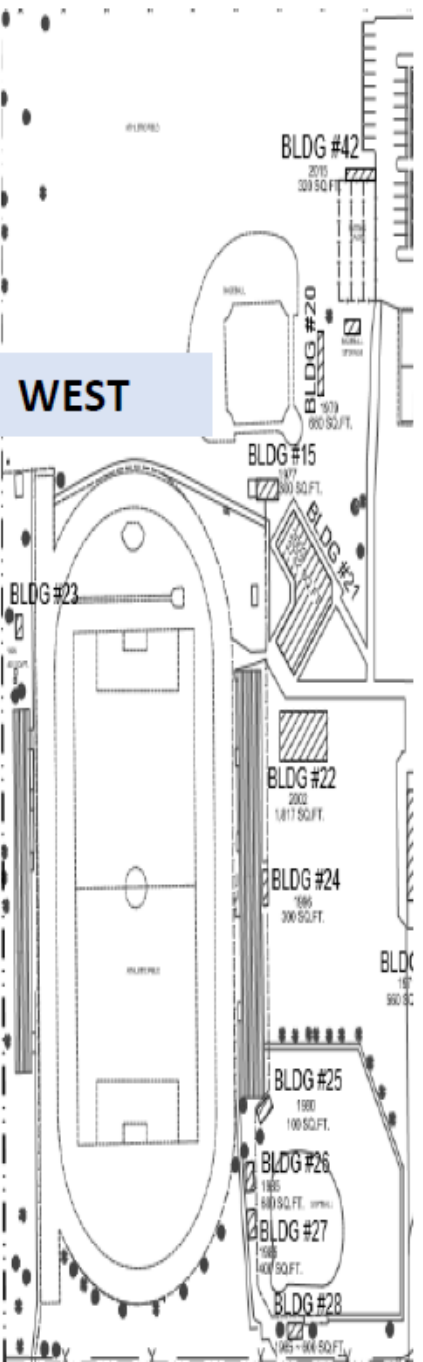

Based on your 3rd/7th period class in 3900 Bldg., NJROTC (142-137), 139, 147, Art, Band, Chorus

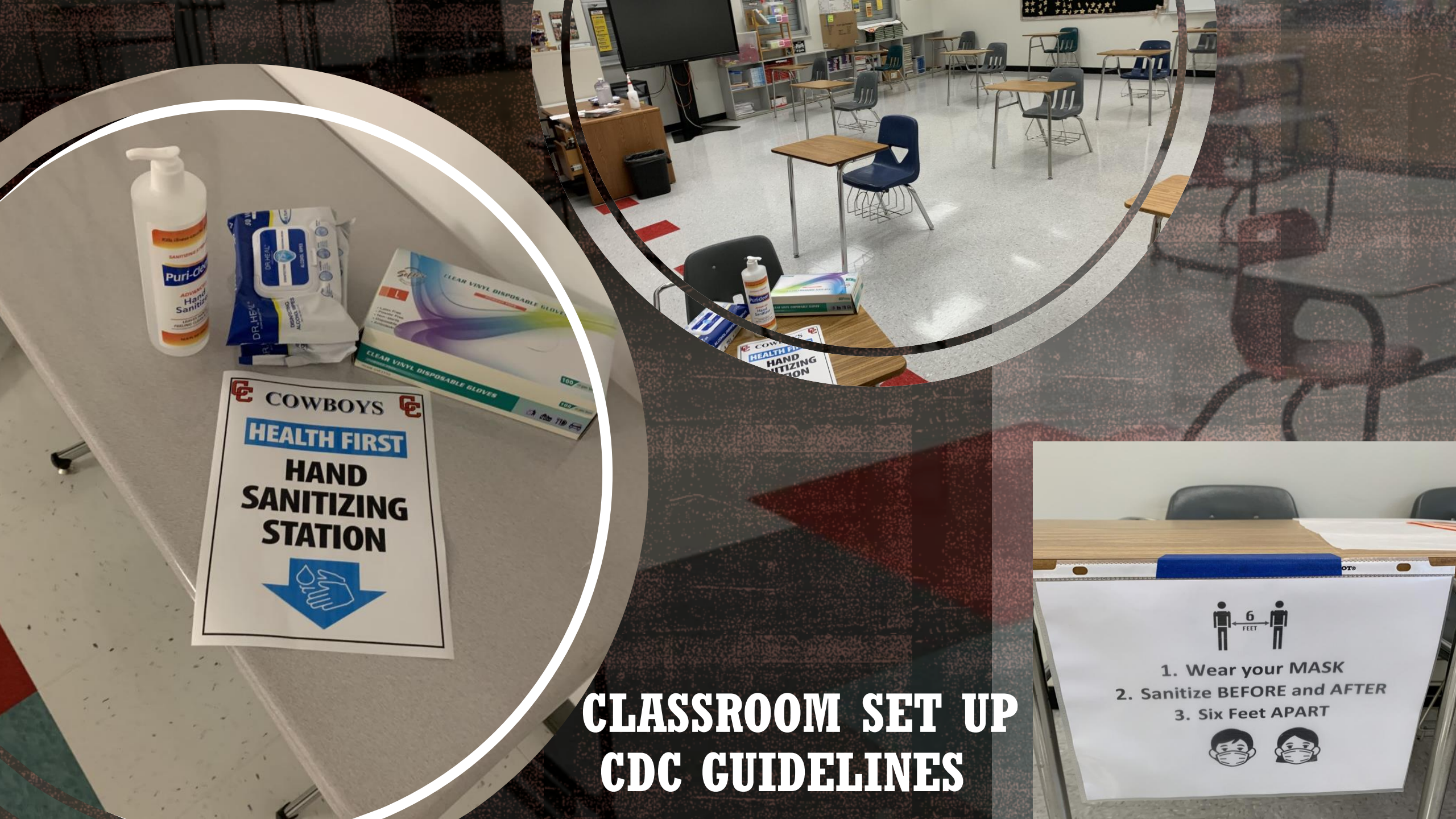
## **B LUNCH—12:30 pm-1:00 PM**

# RESTROOMS & WATER FOUNTAINS

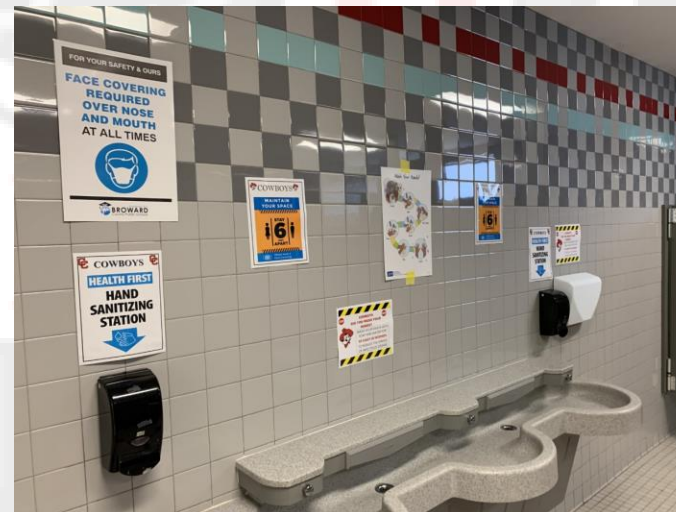


## Restrooms

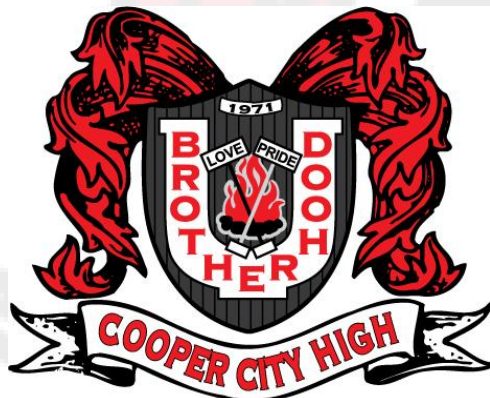
# GUIDANCE & MEDIA CENTER

## Guidance

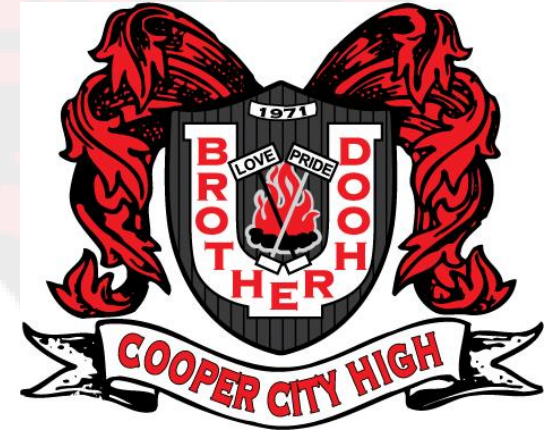
- Students make appointments with guidance counselors through Bookings on their Canvas page
- Appointments can take place before school, after school, lunch time or during personalization

## Media Center

- If students need to go to the media center during their personalization their teacher will call the media center and send the student with an electronic pass
- Students can make copies in the media for a charge



# SIGN-OUT PROCEDURES



- Virtual sign out procedure: (No later than 2:00 pm each day)
- ❑ Parent will complete online sign-out form process as posted on the school website.
  1. Copy of the Parent's Driver's License
  2. Student's name
  3. Grade Level
  4. Time of Dismissal
  5. Parent Contact Phone Number
- ❑ Once confirmed, the parent will provide their information to the security staff at the front gate and drive to the front of the school to wait for their child.
- ❑ Student affairs will call the teacher to send the student to student affairs.
- ❑ The student will meet their parent in the parking lot.

## Staggered dismissal by announcements
