CTE	The CTE department will work on "The Wishing Garden" project.	Students and staff will write or draw their wish on a card. They will tie the card to one of the designated trees in the Wishing Garden. They will then take a moment... and wish it true.
ELA	Team Literacy will focus on positive messages through writing for the MSD Memorial project. The project title is "What We Put In Writing: Our Words Matter".	ELA will be sharing and posting positive quotes on the power of words and kindness, as well as having students write notes of encouragement to unsung heroes/ unexpected individuals.
ESE	The ESE Department will be providing lunch to CC first responders on a day they determine.	Students will make "Thank you for your Service" cards and posters.
Fine Arts	The Fine Arts Department will be doing Pinwheels for Peace.	Students at home and in school will create a pinwheel [directions will be provided and posted on Canvas]. Directions for decorations will be modified to resemble each Fine Arts class specialty. Example: Chorus + Musical Theater will include lyrics that symbolize peace; Film will decorate with movie quotes that are inspiring; etc. Students at home can place their pinwheel in their yard/window, and those at school, will display them in a designated area.

Through Naviance, students will also be receiving a kindness messages from the Guidance Department.
