



Drafting

About this Program

The purpose of the Drafting program is to prepare students for employment or advanced training in the drafting and/or architecture industry. The program consists of three courses that provide for the technical knowledge used in the industry as well as training and certification in the use of the drafting software; AutoCAD and Revit. Students who partake in this program will be benefited in three ways. First, students will obtain instruction in basic drawing and drafting skills, applied mathematics, multi-view, and sectional drawings. Second, students will acquire competencies in basic architectural and civil computer-aided drafting and design, as well as an overview of the history of the built environment. Third, students will obtain knowledge regarding computer-aided drafting skills, professional ethics and career, and education planning. The students who matriculate through the drafting program should be well prepared to enter into the Architecture or Construction industry or to further their education at a college or university.
