- 1) Principal Address- Ms. Marie Hautigan
 - a. 2021/2022 school year – returning to traditional face-to-face teaching/learning for all students
 - b. CDC Guidelines Changing
 - i. Piper steadfast in protecting health and safety of students and staff
 - (1) Fewest reported cases at Broward schools
 - ii. Vaccinations are available to staff and faculty of Broward schools
 - c. Students are struggling with remote learning
 - i. Lack of connection
 - ii. Can't participate in same way
 - iii. Kids can't stay on computers for so long – wearing everyone down
 - d. Already planning for fall
 - i. Want to see Piper move to high performing A school
 - e. State ending some testing mandates
 - i. Piper still offering and want students to come in and test to be able to see if students need remediation or enrichment
 - ii. Graduation test requirements no longer needed for current graduating seniors
 - iii. Data-driven school: we are structuring the curriculum to encompass all needs and differentiate for each child
 - f. Shout-out FSA Attendance
 - i. 9th grade last week, 10th this week
 - ii. SAT 11th grade – needed to put more desks for students who showed up to test
 - iii. Everyone was social distancing and masking
 - g. Cambridge testing begins April 26 – all tests will be in person per United Kingdom
 - h. Girls Flag Football doing really great
 - i. Cleaning up and upgrading all athletics facilities
 - j. New media center coming soon – will be renovated and modern
 - i. Coffee bar/high tops with charging stations
 - ii. Mini classrooms for presentations
 - iii. Summer will be spent on improving the campus

- k. In-person summer school: students can make up credits not earned due to struggles with curriculum or remote learning
 - i. Piper students will go to Bair because of construction
