- 1. All clubs continue to operate in a virtual setting until otherwise notified (club members are not to organize on-campus or off-campus in any capacity as it pertains to activity related to their specific club). Project approval forms can be submitted and we will look at each request individually with safety the highest of priorities.
- 2. Club meetings and parameters for meeting have been established by your club sponsor and club officers. Meetings should take place on an approved platform set forward by the Broward County Public Schools. In this case, Cypress Bay is encouraging the use of TEAMS as the appropriate platform.
- 3. Club fundraising should be discussed with club sponsors and in many cases will need to be tempered due to the economic impact of COVID-19 on so many across South Florida.
- 4. IOC meetings have begun and will held virtually until otherwise notified. Each club is expected to have representation at these meetings.
- 5. Due to the impact of COVID-19 and the many logistical challenges it presents, we have frozen any new clubs for the 2020-21 school year. We plan on opening up our portal for new club applications in February 2021. If you applied last year, we would encourage you to re-apply in February 2021.
- 6. Next week will be Club Rush week as a great deal of information will be available about our many clubs at Cypress Bay. Students should monitor their Class Canvas page for further information.
