While the FHSAA did decide last evening to remain on their traditional calendar start date of July 27 for the commencement of Fall sports practices, the Broward County School District and Cypress Bay remain in a holding pattern until we have a better grasp of the escalating COVID-19 cases and how we can ensure and maximize student safety.

ALL FALL SPORTS (Cross Country, Football, Golf, Swimming, and Girls Volleyball) cannot begin traditional practices until a TBD time and date. Further, schools are not permitted to have any organized activity on school campuses until district approval is provided.

There are several steps that must take place before we can resume full activity on campuses. As we get the information and navigate a plan to implement, we will keep everyone informed.

We are 100% committed to all our student-athletes and sports teams having a season and activity for the 2020-21 school year!
