4. Ms. Johnson provided updates on committees of the FACE program and services.
5. Mr. Espinosa and Ms. Cerda discussed our attendance/student recognition program to celebrate those students on track and to encourage positive behavior from others beginning January 2022.
6. Mr. Most presented on the accountability funds; there are no changes from October report. 439 students met one or more of their graduation requirements as a result of the investment approved by SAC.
7. SAGA presentation was provided by Ms. Jones-Gardner. The goal is to remediate after class instruction.
8. Mr. Most provided the Principal's Report and discussed SESIR update concerns. There were 13 SESIR level incidents for the month of November that were reported to the state as required. "We must be laser focused on the results we want to see from students." Staff holiday party is December 14th.
9. SAF update was presented by Mr. Singer. In class assignments must be provided in class not on applications like remind. Request was made for non-staff adults to discuss and present to school staff suggestions made or concerns raised.
