**Call to Order without quorum at 3:34 PM**

A meeting of the Hollywood Hills High School Advisory Council (SAC) was held in the media center on October 5, 2021. Co-Chair Lided Cerda called the meeting to order at 3:35 pm. Secretary, Shane Salter recorded minutes for this meeting.

**Minutes:**

**New Business: Reports**

1. Literacy Data: 75% of students have been tested and data shared with teachers. Teachers will be meeting on Thursday in PLC groups to discuss baseline and common assessments. Reading department is waiting on back ordered books.
2. Guidance Report & Math Data- Ms. Pierce reported that they are Laser focus on prep for PSAT and SAT on October 13th. Students missing concordance scores will be earned through the upcoming test.
3. SIP Plan-Ms. Pierce shared that the framework and guidance to ensure we are complying. The plan was submitted on time and it is pending review and approval. Ms. Johnson will share more information next meeting.
4. Security & Construction Update-Mr. Most shared that the inspectors only work until 4pm so the inspections will take 3-4 weeks to complete. Otherwise the roof repairs are moving along. Construction will be suspended during PSAT and SAT testing next week. Signs are being created and placed on the fence to designate class locations for each room during drills. Security is doing a great job keeping students out of hallway.
5. SADD- Students shared that the purpose of the club is to empower students to engage in positive change through leadership and smart decision making. The vision is for a healthy and safer world one decision at a time. During national teen safe driver week, 10/17-10/23 because auto accidents is the Leading cause of death for students between 15-18-year old. Safety Tips will be shared during morning announcements. Ms. Silber is the advisor.
6. Hispanic Heritage Month Ms. Cabot is the Advisor for Latinos in Action is leading the effort to highlight Hispanic Awareness Month 9/15-10/15. The program is open to the entire school. The club is spreading the love of Hispanic culture throughout the month and on morning announcements. They will be leading the "parade of nations" held during lunch time pending administration approval. Ms. Pierce shared that The First Lady of Florida's annual state contest for writing is currently underway. The Winner of the contest gets a 4-year scholarship.
7. ESOL Parent Night will be October 27<sup>th</sup>. The speaker will focus remarks on college and career readiness. They will be talking with 9-11<sup>th</sup> grade parents about canvas, pinnacle and the American school system. More information to come via robo-call and invitations.
8. Culinary Club- Mr. Leonardi was not present for report and postponed for next meeting.

9. SESIR/State of School Address Reviewed data for the month of September: First quarter ends two weeks from today. State requires us to discuss the SESIR data. There are 26 infractions in the discipline matrix identified by the state. This data is required to be reported on by each school district. Mr. Most provided overview of the infractions and stated that he will be sharing this data with SAC each month. HHHS staff made 63 referrals for tardy and skipping so far this year. 9 incidents of fighting and a few incidents of physical attacks. Students have been suspended for physical damage done in bathrooms. Two students who compromised school fire extinguishers were charged with felonies. Mr. Most concluded with update on spirit week from 10/3-10/8. Monday was pajama day, Tuesday was Crocs, Wednesday is Pink for Breast Cancer, Thursday is Grade color wars, Friday is sports team day. More than 200 hundred tickets have been sold for homecoming. 10/7 is last day of ticket sales. 9, 10, 11<sup>th</sup> grade students are scheduled for PSAT and 12<sup>th</sup> graders are also scheduled for SAT on next Thursday.
