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The Cambridge Curriculum

- Internationally recognized qualifications (exams)
- Excellence in education
- Learner-centered approach
- Stresses deep thinking and problem solving
- Makes learning both rigorous and relevant
- The diploma Focuses on four areas: Science/math, Language, social sciences, interdisciplinary studies.
- Students can take other courses as electives based on interests and preferences.

of Cambridge

- Internationally recognized high rigor curriculum designed to provide students with a collegiate level experience while in high school.
- Allows access to the top level of Florida Bright Futures Scholarship.
- Access to College credits accepted by many universities across the country.

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What is Global Gators?

- Global Gators is a rigorous co-curricular academic program put on jointly by Glades Middle and Everglades High School.
- Zero-period where 8th grade students will be able to take a class every other day at Everglades high School.
- Pre-AICE Global Perspectives – A state level honors course that provides an introduction to the only mandatory Cambridge course.




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Zero-Period School Day

- Arrive to Everglades campus no later than 7:30am
- A morning congregation area will be available for middle school students
- Students will be able to eat breakfast from the Everglades Cafeteria during normal breakfast time.
- Students will take their course from 7:40 –9:10 at Everglades High School
- Students would then be transported to their normal school day at Glades Middle.

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Benefit of Zero-Period

- Access to an additional State Level honors credit.
- Potential to skip the application process for Everglades Cambridge.
- Access to PSAT as an 8th Grade student

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Application Process and Criteria



- Current 7th grade students that have a 4 or 5 on the FSA
- Must complete the application that can be found on either school website.
- Space is very limited and will be filled on a first come first serve basis.
- Acceptance is contingent on current years test scores.
