- In order to apply they must have a minimum GPA of 2.5, excellent attendance, and no disciplinary history.
- Students can apply for the program beginning in their **10th grade** year.

The Applied Cybersecurity is a **4-year pathway** that will teach students the tools and systems used to monitor, mitigate, and prevent online threats.
































Cybersecurity professionals use innovative technology to combat hackers, cyberterrorists, network outages, and other technical problems that compromise network security.

- The **Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC)** program is more than a class—it's an opportunity to develop as a leader, collaborator, and community member while fulfilling a high school graduation requirement.
- By focusing on leadership, teamwork, and followership, JROTC equips students with essential skills for future success in college, careers, and life.
- The JROTC program is structured across four levels, each building upon the last to develop well-rounded, capable leaders.
- **Two years of JROTC with a grade of C or higher will waive the Performing Arts and PE requirements**

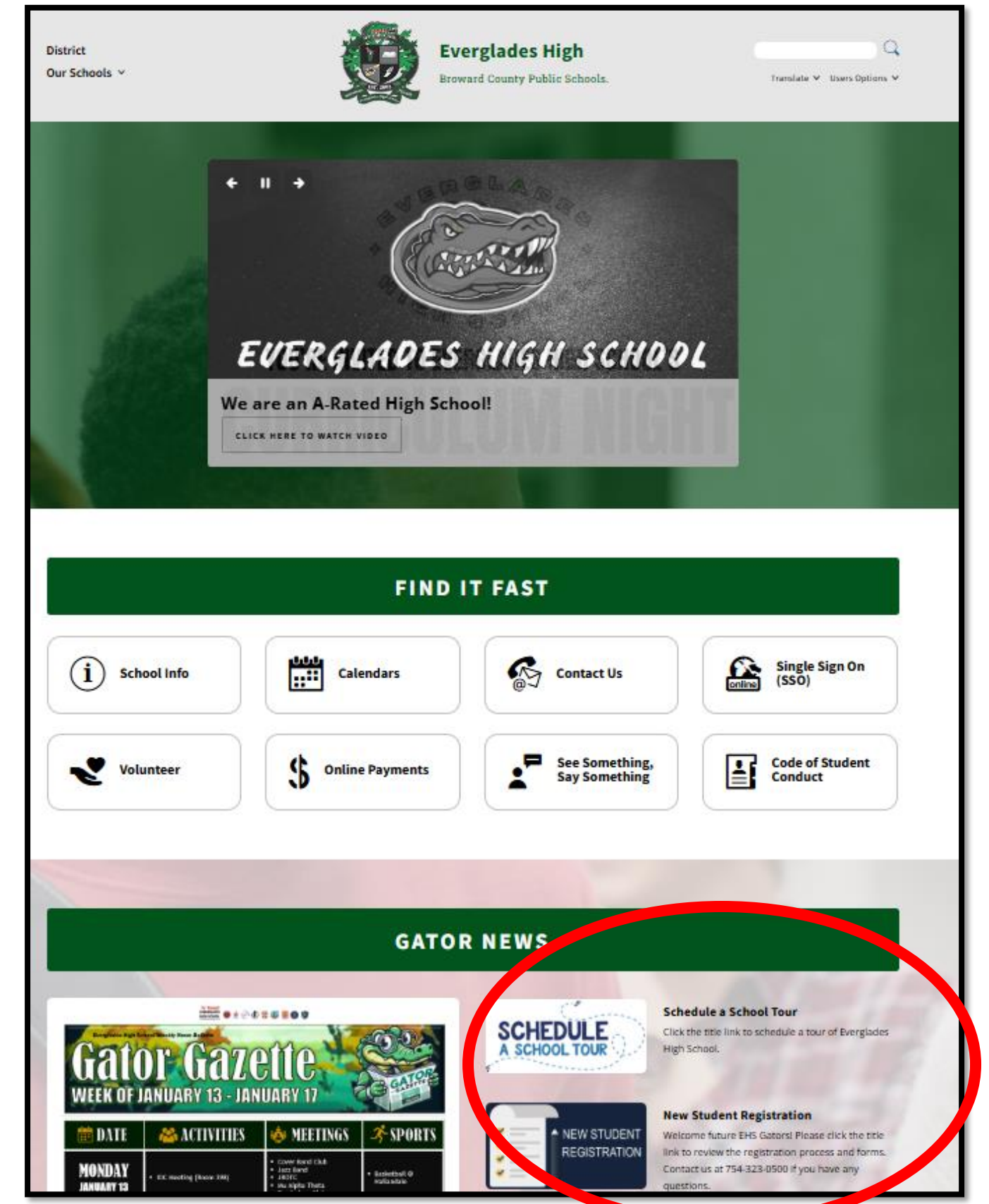


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NEXT STEPS

1. Students that currently attend Glades Middle School, New Renaissance Middle School, Silver Trail Middle School, or Walter C Young Middle School that are **ZONED** for Everglades High School will be automatically rolled over to Everglades High School.
 - A. No additional actions are required.
2. Students that are zoned for EHS but do not currently attend one of the schools listed above:
 - A. Confirm EHS is the school assigned to your home address using the Find My School feature on the BCPS website.
 - B. If Everglades High School is your zone school, you may register by completing the steps on the EHS website under “**New Student Registration**”
3. If Everglades High School is not your zone school, you must apply for reassignment through the BCPS Office of School Choice at <https://www.browardschools.com/schoolchoice>
 - a. ****Open Enrollment for the 2025/26 school year is open now through January 21, 2025. We encourage anyone interested in reassignment to apply****
