Good morning FLHS Community:

We wanted to reach out to you and make sure that all of our students are comfortable with the transition to Distance Learning. We know that it may be challenging to transition so we wanted you to keep a few things in mind:

- 1. We have moved from the traditional A/B (Blue/White) day to a more fluid day that no longer relies on the Blue/White Calendar.
- 2. Students should view their schedule in a weekly fashion making sure that they log into Canvas daily and are able to get all of their assignments done each week.
- 3. Teachers will provide lessons and supplemental materials via Canvas to ensure that students are able to master content, skills and standards.
- 4. If the student needs support, he/she should look up the teacher's office hours that are posted in Canvas and coordinate with the teacher who will provide assistance during the posted Office Hours. Students can email teachers via Canvas.
- 5. The school and our teachers are customizing Canvas pages for our ESE support Facilitators, Guidance Counselors, Social Worker and BRACE Advisor. BRACE will also continue communication through Naviance.

Click on a Canvas tile - choose from 1 to 7 of your courses to enter each day using the "Courses" button on the left hand panel

Entering class means:

- 1. Click on the 'Announcements' Tab. Read the announcements and if you still have further questions or concerns you may email your teachers via Canvas.
- 2. Click on the 'Assignments' Tab. Monitor due dates and complete assignments accordingly. Please be sure to 'submit' after you complete assignments. Repeat for each course you are enrolled in.

Teacher interaction may be provided using live video conferencing, prerecorded video and Canvas chats and discussion.
